Why Is The City's Internet Service So Bad? Council Asks

A speedy Internet connection that can handle the demands of Zoom meetings, remote learning, and simple tasks such as paying monthly bills is a lifeline for El Segundo households and small businesses in the COVID-19 era. However, service across the city is spotty, and the fastest broadband service isn't available to everyone. So, city leaders on Tuesday called in local broadband providers for a chat about the situation.

Representatives for AT&T, Spectrum, and Verizon appeared before the City Council to explain how their fiber-optic networks work, including their plans to expand access for residential and business customers. The onramp to the digital highway, known as broadband, is closed to many El Segundo customers because they live or work too far from the hard-wired network. Charles Mallory, the city's director of Information Technology, lamented the situation in a report prepared ahead of Tuesday's face-to-face meeting with local telecommunications companies that service the El Segundo area.

"There is limited access to the higher capacity digital highways that deliver broadband into the community," Mallory informed City Council members. Once the Internet signal leaves the fiber-optic networks, it passes through much slower telephone wires and coaxial cable. "As a result, speed and quality of service in different parts of the city vary considerably," he added.

It's not just an El Segundo problem. Fiber-optic networks across the South Bay and Los Angeles County have limitations that residents and companies know all too well. They are divided into the haves and have-nots for reliable, high-speed Internet service. Broadband service is essential to businesses, and newcomers to El Segundo are paying \$100,000 or more to have fiber-optic cabling and relay equipment

installed. However, for small businesses, that amount is beyond their reach, so they go without, according to Mallory.

AT&T plans to expand its fiber-optic network to residential customers, said company spokesman John Heffernan. The company for 140 years used copper phone lines and cables to connect customers with a central office. The telecommunications giant began using fiber-optic as a conduit for telephone, cable TV, and Internet service in the early 2000s, "but still there was the copper connection going to people's homes," he said.

Fiber optic cables transfer data signals in the form of light and travel hundreds of miles

much faster than traditional electrical cables, according to Verizon. One of the reasons: the fiber optics are non-metallic, so they aren't slowed down by electromagnetic interference. The main source of the data slowdown is the weather, Verizon explains.

Signal strength and speed slow once data exits the lightning-fast network and travels over what is called "the last mile" connection. AT&T intends to address the lack of connectivity by installing fiber-optic lines on utility poles in El Segundo neighborhoods, Heffernan revealed Tuesday. No timetable for the project was given.

Master of His Craft: Joe Cariati Discusses Glass Blowing

You may have heard the name Joe Cariati, or perhaps you've seen some of his beautiful glassworks at places like Nieman Marcus or Barney's New York. Couldn't find his noir collection, or missed his decanter trio? Good news! Cariati's studio is located right here in El Segundo.

Originally from Malibu, Joe Cariati is an artist, a sculptor in a two thousand four hundred fifty degrees medium. He has a series of

end. The next step, effectively, is to blow a bubble into the molten glass. After the bubble has been formed, the bubble is necked down and broken off the blow pipe. At this point, most mass manufacturer's process stops. This goes into a mold, and it is produced to scale.

Cariati takes the next step. His glass is not mold-blown. It is free-blown, meaning it can't be replicated or copied by being blown into a mold. He then transfers the bubble onto another rod called a punty, which holds the

bottles, decanters, barware, jars, and lighting, all of his designs are handcrafted by him. A teacher, a businessman, and a creator all in one, Cariati has immersed himself in the world of glass blowing.

Glass is created by mixing raw materials such as sand, soda ash, limestone, and barium into a crucible (like a pot) inside a furnace. After melting for over twelve hours, and resting for a full day, what's left is molten glass.

From here, the glass blowing process begins. Blow pipes, the instrument used to blow air into a vessel, were created around the time of Christ.

This long tubular rod is then spun in the molten glass, making a Q-tip shape at the

glass from the bottom so that he can mold the top of the vessel, be it a long neck or a folded down lip.

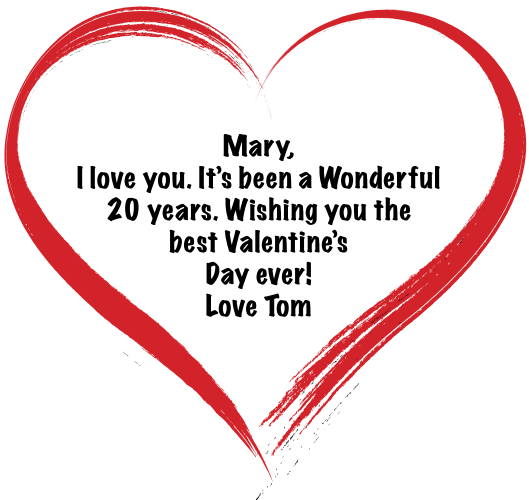
Cariati also distinguishes himself as a designer/maker in production style, not a glass artist. As he explains, glass blowing has largely always been about production. Say, for example, a high powered citizen commissions a glass design for their dinnerware in Europe in the 16th century. The glass blower creates a design, and the client asks for one hundred. The glass blower's job is then to make one hundred of the same piece, using their knowledge, muscle memory, and skill.

Glass artists appeared around the 1960s and

Two Standouts from the 2021 Sundance Film Festival

By the time you read this, the 2021 Sundance Film Festival will have concluded. Award-winners will have been crowned and the buzziest indie films will start making their way into the mainstream. As we write this, we are only three days into the festival’s run and have already seen over 15 films (with coffee brewing non-stop). Among the films we’ve seen, here are two standouts that we can’t stop thinking about.

A Doc That Conceals His Identity, *Flee* Recounts One Man’s Flight For Survival

Remarkably moving in both its story and delivery, Jonas Poher Rasmussen’s animated feature *Flee* is a must-watch. Expanding our idea of what a documentary can be, *Flee* is a depiction of an Afghan refugee’s decades-long flight for survival and, most importantly, self-acceptance. Executive produced by Riz

live a day at a time. Set against a haunting soundtrack from American-Icelandic artist Low Roar, *Flee* is one of the most profound films I’ve seen in a long time.

Edgar Wright Fanboys it Up in *The Sparks Brothers*, His Love Letter to the Enigmatic Duo

Spanning two hours and twenty minutes, it’s clear that Edgar Wright feels indebted to both educate, as well as attempt to make audiences appreciate, art-pop duo Sparks—the most influential band that you’ve never heard of—in his first documentary, *The Sparks Brothers*.

An unabashed pop music fan himself (whose films’ perfectly-placed needle drops have attributed to his own film geek following), Wright makes it his mission to not only tell the story of the Mael brothers, Ronald and Russel, but capture their undefinable creative identity and show how real commercial success would evade them over their entire career

The film begins with a title card informing us that what we are about to watch is based on a true story, but some names and locations have been changed to protect identities and avoid persecution. For the next hour and a half, we become wrapped up in the story of Amin (a pseudonym) as he tells his harrowing journey growing up as a young gay man who was always on the run from the police, the government, and his own feelings. Forever in flux, Amin shows how it is impossible to plan for the future when you’re forced to

refusing to sell out. Their career spanned over five decades in which the pair made 25 studio albums and 500 songs.

Even if you’re not aware of Sparks’ music (which you likely aren’t) or even entirely “get” their music (which mass audiences didn’t), *The Sparks Brothers* is a fantastic story about creative artists who are unafraid to chart forward, change the formula, and evolve to new places. And while they wanted to be successful despite their outsiderhood, they never settled for anything that would compromise their unique vision. So they chose to be the best band that you’ve never heard of—until now. •

Address: 650 and 700 North Pacific Coast Highway and 737 Carl Jacobson Way (Lairport Street)

Purpose: In accordance with the State of California Public Resources Code Section 21092, Sections 15063 and 15072 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations pertaining to the California Environmental Quality Act, and the El Segundo Municipal Code, this is to advise you that the Planning Division of the City of El Segundo has prepared an initial study of environmental impacts on the following project and is recommending the environmental determination described below.

Project Description: The Project would involve the renovation and minor alteration of two existing office buildings on the Project site: Building A at 650 North Pacific Coast Highway, with a net addition of 1,031 square feet to the existing 98,885 square feet, for a total of 99,916 square feet; and Building B at 700 North Pacific Coast Highway, with a net reduction of 4,572 square feet from the existing 69,692 square feet, for a total of 65,120 square feet. The Project would also include construction of a new 122,156-square-foot, 7-level office building with an integrated parking structure to the east of Building A (referred herein as Building C). Building C would include 70,921 square feet of office space and 1,185 parking spaces. No alteration is proposed to the building at 737 Carl Jacobson Way. The Project would also consolidate the seven parcels of land that make up the Project site into a single approximately 7.3-acre parcel. In addition to the renovation and new construction of the site, the Project would amend El Segundo Municipal Code (ESMC) Section 15-1-6 to exempt the parking area of a fully integrated parking structure from the definition of Floor Area Ratio (FAR). The following applications/approvals are being requested:

- A Zone Text Amendment to amend the definition of floor area ratio (FAR) in the El Segundo Municipal Code (ESMC) Section 15-1-6 to exempt the parking area of a fully integrated parking structure within a new construction building.
- A Vesting Tentative Parcel Map to consolidate seven parcels into one, 7.3-acre parcel.
- A Site Plan Review for a new commercial development that includes structures which have a combined gross floor area of more than 50,000 square feet.
- Waivers of Street Dedication requirements on North Pacific Coast Highway, Mariposa Avenue and Carl Jacobson Way.

Environmental Determination: Mitigated Negative Declaration. An initial study of environmental impacts was prepared pursuant to 14 California Code of Regulations § 15063 ("CEQA Guidelines"). A Mitigated Negative Declaration of Environmental Impacts is proposed for this project pursuant to CEQA § 15070. The public review and comment period for the Mitigated Negative Declaration begins on February 5, 2021 and ends at 5:00 p.m. on March 10, 2021. Spectrum pulled fiber-optic lines through El Segundo, including the Smoky Hollow area, and can reach most small- and medium-sized businesses with what representatives describe as a hybrid system. The fiber and coax materials deliver entry-level speeds of 200 megabytes per second for residential customers that receive data, but don’t send much. Spectrum also offers a 400-megabyte speed for home-based businesses that transmit large files. And it sells a top-of-the-line one gigabyte service for business customers, according to the reps.

A large business and major employer might need up to 100 gigabytes to handle its data transmissions and Internet traffic needs, in which case Spectrum would need to build a fiber-optic connection to accommodate them. In some cases, Spectrum will pay the installation and construction costs for small and medium businesses for the hookup.

American Dark Fiber, a private utility company in the market, illuminated for the council an obscure niche in the fiber-optic industry. Calling itself “the Switzerland” of the telecom sector, American Dark Fiber shares the public right-of-way for high-speed Internet and data traffic with the telecom giants. Dark fiber is the unlit cable in an 864-strand of fiber, founder and chief executive officer Dave Daigle explained.

“Our friends at Verizon, AT&T, and Spectrum will tell you that to develop rudimentary infrastructure in the public right-of-way is a very expensive proposition,” he said. “It can cost anywhere from \$75,000 to \$250,000 per mile to deploy fiber-optic cable.”

Daigle’s company is responsible for the devel-

opment of the South Bay Fiber Optic Network, and despite its anonymity, plays an important role in extending broadband service to areas of El Segundo and the region that need it. The South Bay Network covers an estimated 100 miles and took two years to complete, he said.

Councilman Scot Nicol questioned if it’s unusual that El Segundo has three broadband carriers, and yet his neighborhood is only serviced by one of them. “Is that typical, or are we living in the Stone Age here?” Nicol asked. Spectrum’s rep said its service is available citywide, except in small-business areas and multi-dwelling units. Without a signed agreement with an owner, Spectrum can’t provide its service.

Ninety percent of addresses in most zip codes are usually served by at least two carriers, according to Spectrum. AT&T has plans to expand its broadband service in 2012 to an additional 1,000 homes, according to its spokesman.

Councilman Lance Giroux didn’t sugarcoat his displeasure with the hit-or-miss service options available within El Segundo. “This an affluent community with million-dollar tear-downs right on 6,000 square-foot lots,” he said, adding, “there are some expectations from businesses and residents who live here when you buy and pay that much money - for services to be of the same level.”

After listening to the presentations from the carriers - including AT&T that has its headquarters in the city - and their plans to expand and lengthen the fiber networks, Giroux said, “Here’s my question: Why’s it still so bad?”

He pressed for a timeline to fix the broadband issues that are a source of frustration for

residential and business customers. Giroux said he’d witnessed a huge spike in the number of complaints on the Neighborhood Network social media about local Internet services.

The Verizon representative asked for clarification of what Giroux meant by “bad” service. Is it speed that’s bad, or quality of service, or the fact that not every home is serviced by Verizon, asked spokeswoman Gail Kodama.

“Check, check, check,” Councilman Giroux replied.

AT&T has identified six clusters, or neighborhoods, in need of broadband upgrades in 2021, and its spokesman promised to lobby for another six to be retrofitted in 2022.

In Other Action:

- El Segundo recognized Black History Month in February with a proclamation urging all citizens to “join together in making this period of rededication to the principles of justice and equality for all people.” The tradition dates back to 1926, and for many years the second week of February was set aside for the observance to coincide with the birthdays of two great Americans: Abraham Lincoln and Frederick Douglas, the proclamation notes.
- Results of the annual satisfaction survey about city services were released. Approximately 5,000 businesses and 2,600 residents received surveys last year. The highest grades went to fire and police personnel for responsiveness, availability, and expertise. The lowest scores were given to the city’s vision and responsiveness and to the water and sewer department’s customer service. Negative perceptions and concerns about El Segundo centered around the cost

of living and taxes, and the airport and noise.

- Just in time for pothole season, the city unveiled a “Report an Issue” form on its website for alerting city departments to street damage, fallen trees, and abandoned parked vehicles. Details are available at [elsegundo.org](#).
- A 2020 pavement rehabilitation project on sections of east Imperial, east Pine, and California Street came in 20 percent below the estimated cost of \$365,000. Seven other streets were restriped as part of the project, which was funded by SB 1 grants. Motorists and vehicle owners are paying higher fuel taxes and vehicle fees to repair California’s roads and highways under the transportation funding package passed in 2017.
- The council waived \$50,000 in permit fees and other costs for outdoor dining areas for the year. The recent Stay-at-Home order limited restaurants to takeout and delivery until Friday when Los Angeles County allowed food businesses to resume outdoor dining. El Segundo’s thriving restaurant culture, breweries, and tasting rooms can reopen under the relaxed rules, provided they serve food and practice social distancing.
- The council will oppose a pair of state Senate bills about housing and zoning. Senate Bills 9 and 10, if approved and signed by the governor, would require additional review of permitted projects in El Segundo and impose parking requirements that take the decisions out of the hands of elected city officials. Because the bills usurp local control over zoning and development decisions, the council expressed strong opposition.▪

70s as ceramic artists began experimenting and subsequently teaching. Eventually, Pilchuck Glass School was opened in Seattle, known as one of the pinnacle schools for anyone in the glass community. After the creation of Pilchuck, students were on to making bigger furnaces and traveling the world to discover how glass is made and designed in different countries.

Cariati blows in the Venetian style, which is free-blown on a workbench, very clear, clean, thin, and precise. At one time, Italy was the world leader in glass craft, having created the first clear glass, and they made it illegal for masters to reveal their secrets to any foreign country, lest they incur the death sentence. Other countries would try and steal the Italian masters, and some of them defected to other countries, where they went into hiding. In

1976, an Italian master named Lino came to the United States to teach his work.

Glass blowing, as Cariati describes it, is a kind of niche community in which everyone knows everyone, and familiar faces can be seen at most events. As to how he got into it, his story starts with creative parents.

“There’s definitely some lineage of making things in the family and making things in three dimensions,” he says. His father worked with tools, his grandfather was a carpenter, and his mother taught art and sculpting. Despite this, he was never pushed into the craft, though for the most part, he was “living [his] world in three dimensions.”

In 1992, he went to San Francisco State University, where he saw someone blowing glass, and decided to try it. Shortly after, he

was traveling and teaching with his professor. In 2005, he moved back down to LA, got a studio, and began teaching at Cal State Fullerton.

“Before that, I didn’t think I wanted to be an artist. I didn’t really know what that meant,” says Cariati. In the five years he was teaching, he began making his line of bottles secretly in the background. Finally, he did a trade show in 2007 that changed everything.

Businesses were hot on his work and beautiful designs, and major retailers connected with him. Suddenly his work was in high demand, but he continued to make each and every piece in his studio and conduct his quality control. “My QC is insane. We never get returns. We never get complaints,” he explains, detailing his high level of work and end product.

Through conferences, classes, and showcases,

those truly dedicated to glass get to know every name in the business. Cariati has traveled the world and worked with famous glass blowers all over the globe. He knows all the history, all the steps, and all the players.

These days, things have slowed a little in the midst of the pandemic, but he remains in his studio, continuing to craft his products. Lino Tagliapietra, he explains, is 86, one of the remaining best on the planet, and is still blowing glass.

“If I don’t blow glass for four or five days, I go stir crazy that I’m not making anything...I think I’ll always be a maker and a glass blower.” Creation fuels Cariati, and though he hopes to one day bring education and nonprofit work back into his life, we can be certain we’ll see him in his studio right here in El Segundo. •

couples that with low-cost training for existing businesses and fledgling start-ups.

Not only do these small businesses provide local tax revenue and jobs, but they are also critical to the vibrancy and livability of their communities. Seeing them shutter their doors not only hurts owners and employees but can send economic shock waves through entire communities.

Van Buren, who received her Bachelor of Arts in Communications from California State University at Dominguez Hills, an MBA from the University of Redlands, and her Ed.D from the University of Southern California, has been directing the SBDC for more than a dozen years.

Van Buren initially hailed from Norwalk, CA, spent time in Cypress, and ended up in San Pedro, where she lives with her husband of nearly 28 years.

Van Buren’s main tasks include the development, planning, and organizing of the services and operations of the SBDC. She also is instrumental in managing complex budgets and programs seeking state and federal grants, as well as managing, recruiting, and giving direction to ten consultants; directing the efforts of three administrative staff; actively networking with engaged public and private organizations to help grow the SBDC; develop and help implement the strategic marketing plan; as well as doing her best to ensure that the program dots all the I’s and crosses all of the T’s to ensure that the program complies with the avalanche of federal and state reporting requirements. a slew of other duties too numerous to note.

If her workload with the SBDC is not sufficient to keep her workweek hopping, Van Buren is also the manager of the South Bay Maritime Center, which, pre the COVID 19 shutdown, provided safety training for merchant mariners, and oversaw training contracts for the Federal Bureau of Prisons Terminal Island and Metropolitan Detention Centers.

Van Buren is a lady with a veritable work-related smorgasbord on her work-plate. And one bets that she also may be the person responsible for firing-up the coffee maker for her employees when the SBDC opens its doors each morning, as well as changing the copier

cartridge when it runs out of ink.

In the current environment, one of the key services that the SBDC provides is counseling small business on not only acquiring the funds available from the federal government’s Payment Protection Program, but advising them on how to use the funding so that the business “doesn’t get into trouble,” she said, possibly placing the business in the unfortunate position of having to repay the funds.

The SBDC receives its funding from multiple sources. El Camino College provides a college-owned building on Hawthorne Blvd. for the SBDC to run their programs from.

Since the shutdown took effect last Spring, “businesses are really struggling,” Van Buren said, “nearly half of the people who call are crying because their business was shut down.”

The SBDC is doing its best to secure funding for the small businesses and brainstorm ways for the businesses to pivot and “keep going.” It has been a real challenge, and Van Buren says because not everyone qualifies for a government loan. She also noted how the public’s buying pattern has changed due to the pandemic, which has forced some small businesses to attempt to shift to E-commerce, which many of her clients “know nothing about, because they never had to deal with that before.”

Van Buren said that the most valuable resource offered by the SBDC is “advising. We are there to help them avoid making mistakes.”

One of the businesses that have taken ad-

vantage of the SBDC’s advice is Shift Energy Holdings, Inc. CEO Rodney Alves had this to say about his company’s association with the SBDC: “We have been working with the SBDC since early 2019, and with Starleen since June of 2020,” Aceves emailed. “The SBDC team has assisted us on how to navigate the available funding sources during the pandemic and the different programs we could consider.
