Da Vinci Students Turning Car into a Work of Art for Texas Event

A group of students from the El Segundo-based Da Vinci Design High School will head to Texas next month to present what they hope will be a “mobile masterpiece” at the 39th Annual Houston Art Car Parade, scheduled for April 9-12. The 11th- and 12th-graders in question are part of the campus’s Fine Arts Pathway program, founded and spearheaded by teacher/coordinator Jason Kartez. The group began working on its “Team Art Car” back in November—transforming an actual vehicle into a moving work of art to be showcased at the “Creativity on Wheels” challenge during the prestigious yearly event in the Lone Star State. Hundreds of thousands of spectators will attend, giving the students mass exposure for their efforts. It is the largest of its kind in the world and features more than 250 artistic vehicles.

The idea for this endeavor originated in early 2025 when the celebrated long-time Hot Wheels/Mattel car and toy designer Bryan Benedict reached out to Kartez. “Bryan was a judge for many years at the Houston parade and was looking for a high school teacher in the area to undertake this project,” Kartez said.

With ongoing creative input from Benedict, as well as consultation from experts at the Otis College of Art and Design, Cal Polytechnic San Luis Obispo Support Shop manager Dave Kempken, and Houston-based art car artist and teacher Rickey Polidore, Jr., the students continue to progress towards the final product. Galpin Ford donated a 2009 Taurus to serve as the model. “The theme is a representation of Southern California and the Greater Los Angeles Area that provides both an outsider and insider perspective, divided between the driver and passenger sections,” Kartez explained. For example, the outsider

angle will feature items like billboards, the Hollywood Sign, beach waves, and other depictions of iconic tourist destinations. The insider aspect will be more “reality-based” and touch upon natural disasters, protests, and community scenes, among other subjects that hit home and reflect upon the region’s dichotomy.

The car, which must remain drivable to participate in the parade, will become a moving sculptural display. Materials the students will incorporate in the design include aluminum, glass, spray foam, mosaics, and other mixed media. Kartez reported that the concept is fluid, with more ideas and fine-tuning yet to come. “Right now we are focusing on the bigger elements such as making waves out of glass, and angel wing mirrors,” he said. “The smaller parts will be filled in at the end.” Kartez went on to compare the project

to something in the realm of fringe culture that one might see at the annual Burning Man event in the desert.

Once all components are in place, the Taurus will be transported to Texas by truck. “The goal is to reuse it as a base for future projects,” Kartez said, noting that the car is parked on a build site on campus situated between two storage containers. Those containers came in handy during the recent rains, protecting the add-on pieces from the elements. “The components can be removed and new ones added. The thought is to establish something almost like what a robotics team does year after year.”

Kartez, a professional artist for 25 years and a well-known glass blower, joined Da Vinci four years ago, initially as a 10th-grade instructor, before taking on all three

Inline Hockey Association Championship Saturday

The El Segundo Inline Hockey Association has been around since 1989. The league encourages fun while learning the sport of hockey on skates. The 2025-26 winter season just wrapped up, crowning champions at the revitalized rink at Rec Park. A standing room only crowd watched as the Instructional Division, Mite Division, Squirt Division, and Pee Wee Division each played for bragging rights. Team names are selected by their respective players and are unique.

The Instructional Division scrimmage was played evenly between the Fire Apples and the Sour Apples. This division is all

about learning the game while competing on inline skates for the first time. There are plenty of collisions and falls, but with the safety equipment these young athletes wear, injuries are minimal.

Yetis Take Down the Blue Wave in Mite Division Final

In the Mite Division championship, it was a close game in the first half. But the Yetis took control of the scoring in the second and would go on to win 11-6.

Anthony Markovich scored the game's first goal when the Blue Wave's forward drilled a goal to give the Blue Wave an early 1-0 lead. The Yetis responded with a calculated

play, allowing Dexter Wright to get a clear shot at the net to even the game at 1-1. Trailing 3-1 the Blue Wave's Izac Borata scored inside to make it 3-2. Less than a minute later, Borata scored the equalizer to tie the game. The Yetis controlled the puck down the stretch of the first half and made the most of their possessions. Wright scored on a rebound, and Mia Lang scored on a slap shot to give the Yetis a 5-3 lead at the intermission.

The second half started well, and the two teams traded goals. The Blue Waves started the scoring, and Chance Sandoval took advantage to narrow the deficit to 5-4.

The Yetis responded immediately with a goal by Oliver Bitters. Not to be outdone, the Blue Wave's Sandoval scored on quick handed slap shot to keep the score close at 6-5. Ethan Ganz scored from outside for a 7-5 lead for the Yetis. The Blue Wave's last score came from Eloise Strohl, who slid the puck past the Yetis goalie to make it 7-6.

The Yetis would go on to score the final four goals of the game, including two by Mia Lang and one each by Dexter Wright and Oliver Bitters, and the Yetis captured the Mite Division championship.

ESHS Boys Golf Seeks Third Straight Undefeated Season

Over the past three years, the El Segundo High School's boys golf program has made a name for itself. They are among the most successful programs at El Segundo, and have risen in the ranks among their Southern Section foes. They finished their 2024 season with a CIF Division 5 title, and last year the Eagles repeated their undefeated record. Last season, they were rewarded with promotion to Division 1, the highest division in the Southern Section. Their 15th-place finish meant they did not advance to the second round, a memory the team does not look back on fondly.

This season, the Eagles look to stay unbeatable. They play some tough non-league matches before beginning league play on March 10th against the Torrance Tartars. In recent matches, the Eagles finished sixth and

third, respectively, in the Ayala and Golden Bear tournaments. Juniors Lukas Da Silva and Shaan Patel shone and led the Eagles in scoring.

Head coach David March stated the importance of their third-year players. "These guys are out here every weekend going to their individual tournaments, talking to colleges, always being leaders to the team through their play and their attitude. They make us better in every facet and help us achieve our goals." March added, "Da Silva and Patel entered the program as freshmen and immediately made their mark. Last year, they continued their rise as they led the team in scoring, with Da Silva beating out Patel to win league MVP by less than a stroke."

El Segundo's greatest strength is their experience. They are led by a core of seniors, with Remy Romero, Joey Schobel, and Andre

Sugden all returning as first-team all-league awardees from 2025. The three are also the Eagles' captains and will look to lead El Segundo to another successful campaign. They are joined by seniors Ronald Lemus, Matias Arauz, Tate Pintens, and Theo Bong, who all contribute to the Eagles' strong leadership. This experience makes El Segundo able to handle the pressure, as they have faced it before.

Despite the loss of Jack Harris, who graduated last year and continues his golf career at Stevens Institute of Technology, coach March says the team is poised to fill his shoes. "Our team is led by a crew of very talented and capable seniors who have already contributed to our success in years past. Now it's their turn to make this team theirs, shape their future as they play their final season of high school golf," March remarked.

Coach March says his confidence in the team stems from their year-round commitment, practicing throughout the fall and winter, hitting the weight room twice a week, and building team chemistry in the process. He highlights the squad's camaraderie, saying, "You see a lot of teams that don't talk to each other, aren't friends outside of the team, and this only drags them down. That is not the case for our team. They all connect on a deeper level and keep in touch off the course." He says this helps the players motivate one another to be better every day.

The Eagles are more than ready to fulfill their goals: achieve a third consecutive undefeated season and a top-ten finish in Division 1. With their star-studded roster filled with experience and grit, the El Segundo boys' golf looks to cement itself in school history once again. •

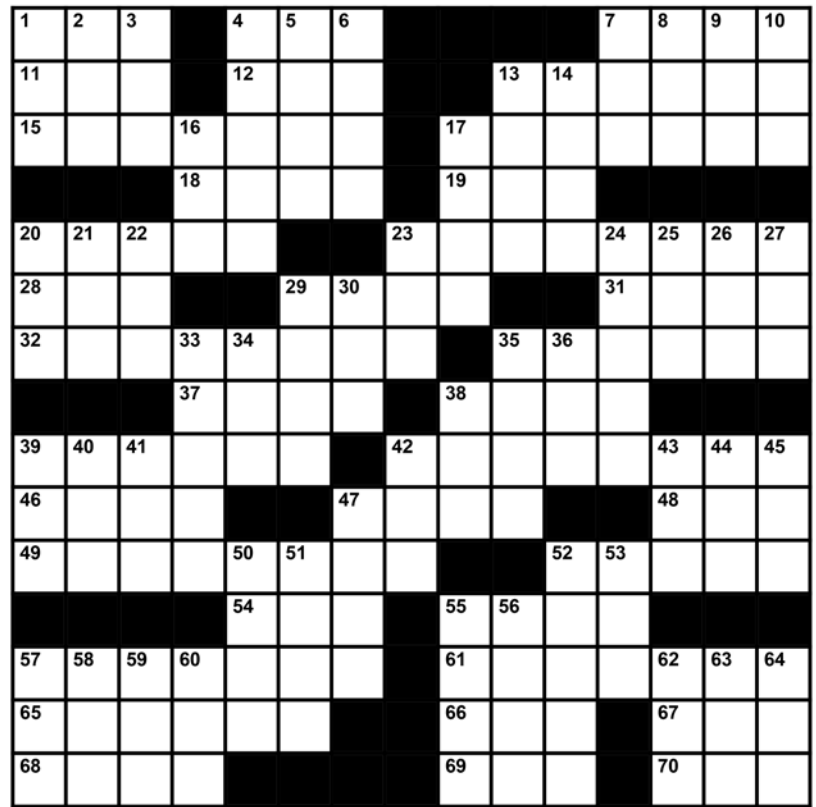

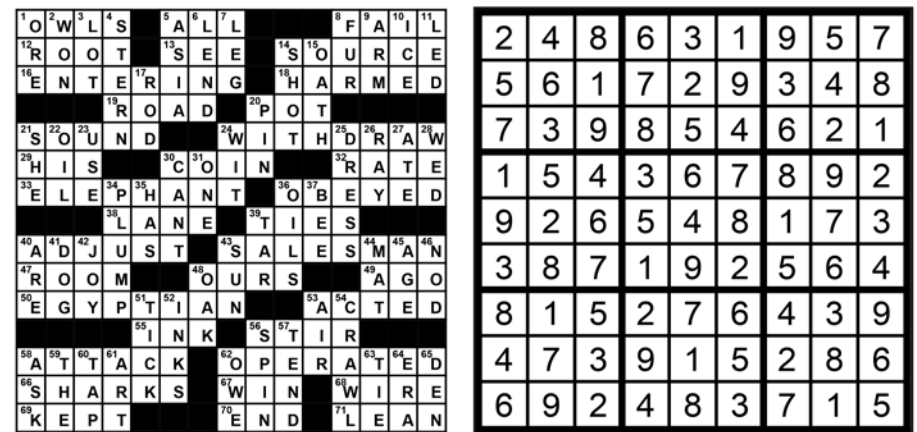

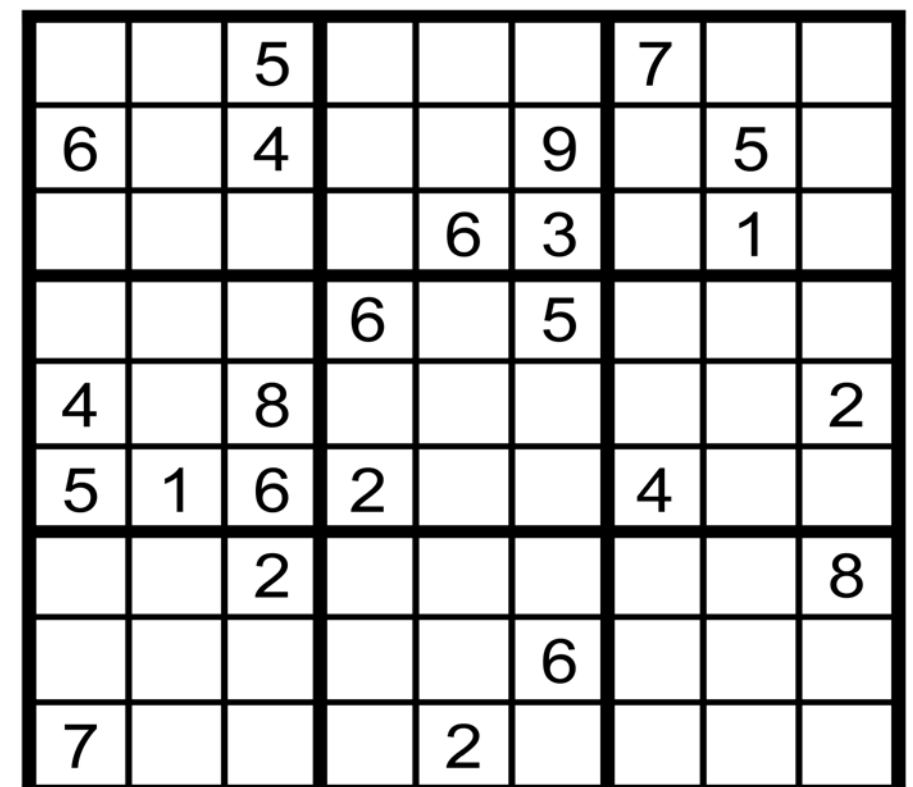

Rockets, Robots, and the Trillion Dollar “Backyard” Merger

Sometimes I’m deeply jealous of my friends, family, and hopefully you, reading this, who don’t understand investment banking. It’s stressful stuff. I have days where the jargon is so thick that even I am faking it till I make it. That said, since SpaceX is right here in our backyard, we have to talk about the massive merger news.

In the largest private acquisition of a company ever, SpaceX has officially merged with xAI. At first, xAI was a roommate I didn’t see coming. If you aren’t a tech-junkie, think of xAI as Elon’s version of ChatGPT. It is the company behind ‘Grok,’ the AI that lives on X (formerly Twitter), and it’s essentially the engine that turns massive amounts of data into intelligence.

I had to cartoonishly double-take, rub my eyes, pinch myself, and make sure I wasn’t dreaming. Traditional mergers involve two different companies coming together, and it’s never straightforward. Think about Netflix and Warner Bros, a deal that started and stopped for many months now, in a kind of purgatory. Next thing you know, Netflix drops pursuit of the deal, setting the stage for Paramount and Warner Bros to merge. Put simply, the deal world can be chaotic. This is different. Elon Musk snapped his fingers, and Hawthorne’s favorite rocket company added an “artificial brain” to go along with its “rocket body.”

To understand why this is happening now, look at the competition. Google co-founder Larry Page recently stated, “I’m willing to go bankrupt rather than lose this race.” That is the level of ‘all-in’ we are talking about. Is bankruptcy hyperbolic? Well, AI does require astronomical (pun, half-intended) amounts of cash. xAI was reportedly burning roughly \$1 billion per month to keep pace. By merging xAI with the profitable, asset-heavy SpaceX, Elon isn’t only protecting the company and trying to capture a few synergies. He’s actively building a war chest that can survive the most expensive race in tech history.

From my perspective, this is less a “mega merger” and more an extremely creative exercise in capital architecture. SpaceX is profitable, generates massive cash, and is approaching public-market scale. Meanwhile, xAI is early, burning through cash, and likely needs a decade of “patient capital” to build its infrastructure. Inside SpaceX, xAI doesn’t have to keep jumping on the “fundraising treadmill” at ever-higher valuations.

Musk gave a capital-hungry AI business a balance sheet that can feed it. He shifted the risk from venture capitalists to a platform that literally prints cash through Starlink. In the banking world, we call this “shock absorption.” Just as Google uses its search engine profits to fund Gemini, SpaceX can

now use its rocket dominance to fund the future of intelligence.

For a lot of my neighbors in Hawthorne, this is a household conversation. When companies of this size merge in the private markets, the ripple effects are huge.

For the Employees: If you’re one of the many locals with equity compensation or stock options, a merger like this changes the “math” of your future. There is the initial excitement, some nervous jitters, and then you wonder what a \$1.5 trillion-dollar IPO would actually mean for you.

For the Investors: Usually, these deals happen behind closed doors. Navigating how to get a piece of a private giant like SpaceX before it hits the public market is complex, with all sorts of rules and bureaucracy to navigate. I’m certainly keeping eyes and ears open.

For the City of Hawthorne (and South Bay broadly): We’re at the nexus of the most ambitious and innovative company on and off Earth. To put it mildly, I think it’s reasonable to feel a certain level of pride!

The 1-Minute MBA: A Cheat Sheet

- Private Market: The “exclusive club” phase, where only big-time investors and employees own shares.
- IPO (est. 2nd half of 2026 for SpaceX): The moment a company goes public.
- Vertical Integration: Owning every step of the process. In this case, not only building the AI but launching the rockets to put a million satellites into orbit to act as the AI’s solar-powered data centers.

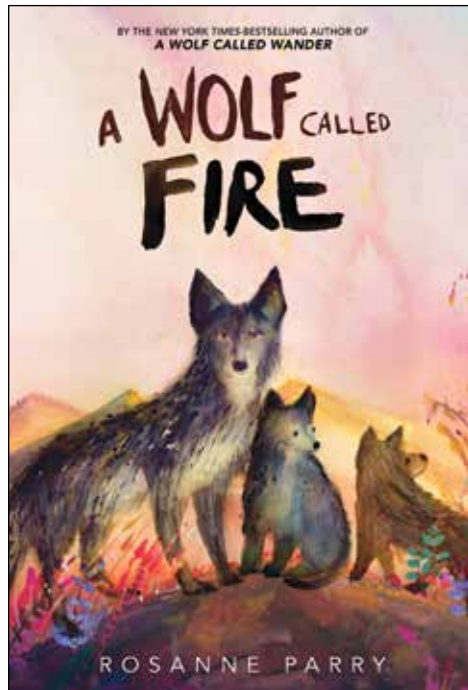
Four new pups are now placed in Warm’s care and survival skills like hunting, finding water and leading a small pack of pups are

levels. Working with kids during his grad school tenure led him to pursue teaching. He moved to the South Bay a few years ago and built a resume that included stints with non-profits, exhibition production, art advocacy, and community-building, among other highlights. A full-time teacher since 2020, he described the DaVinci position as his ideal dream job. "Everything was leading up to this, and it's very rewarding," he said.

A huge portion of that reward was a grant to establish the Fine Arts Pathway program, now in its second year. He hopes to build it going forward with more exciting future projects to come. Currently, the class focuses solely on the team art car and devotes about six hours a week to it—including after-school sessions on Fridays, when parents are also

welcome to come by to watch their creative kids at work. "It's a little like attending a sporting event," Kartez said. "We are creating a community for family and students to come together to do something that's project-based learning and extends beyond the confines of a 90-minute class."

Kartez reiterated the importance of breaking through the barriers that can sometimes limit students and felt that bringing in industry leaders from the outside could have a transformative effect, boding well for their future endeavors. "When you do things that have a real purpose outside of school walls, it shows them that what they're doing can have a real impact beyond just getting a grade," he said. "It also emphasizes professionalism and delivering on time." •
