It's Back: Restored, Renovated Plunge Reopens

The wait is over. The Plunge is back and better than ever, to the delight of El Segundo residents, City officials and business leaders. The beloved Urho Saari Swim Stadium officially reopened last Saturday to a full house getting the first look (and later a chance to jump in the water) at the revamped facility after a ribbon-cutting ceremony celebrating the occasion.

A local mainstay since it debuted in 1941, The Plunge ultimately fell into frequent disrepair with age and eventually shut down completely in 2020. In response to community wishes, the El Segundo City Council allocated capital improvement dollars in August 2023 to renovate the facility while preserving the historic character of the building. The groundbreaking took place the following summer. Recreation, Parks and Library Director Aly Mancini pointed out that the project was actually “more than 10 years in the making” and those involved never lost sight of the goal. “Today, we’re doing more than reopening a building,” she said in her introductory comments last Saturday. “We’re reopening and celebrating a cherished piece of El Segundo’s history and the community that’s kept the spirit of this facility alive for generations.”

Mayor Pro Tem Ryan Baldino looked back at The Plunge’s origins as an “investment back in our community” built over 85 years ago with a then \$45,000 grant from the Works Project Administration. Legendary coach Urho Saari launched El Segundo’s swimming program soon after in 1942 and taught more than 8,000 students over a 32-year tenure that also brought him global acclaim as he

oversaw multiple Pan American and Olympic game teams in swimming and water polo.

Getting into the nuts and bolts of the restoration, City Manager Darrell George spoke of the vision to honor The Plunge’s history while also modernizing it to “serve the community for decades to come.” Among the changes, he listed “the more open and efficient lobby, modern locker rooms, improved seating and gathering spaces, upgraded filtration and mechanical systems, enhanced fire protection, improved accessibility throughout the site, and numerous building and health code improvements.” All this while “preserving the historic character that has made The Plunge

such an iconic part of El Segundo.”

The project came with a hefty price tag that grew to \$18.7 million. The bulk of the monies came out of the City’s capital improvement program budget, but a \$5 million shortfall spurred a fundraising campaign launched by the non-profit South Bay Sports, Health and Recreation (SBSHR, which played a similar role in the joint El Segundo/Wisburn aquatics center on the east side of town). CEO Richard Lundquist, who also owns Continental Development Corporation (CDC), reported, “There is still fundraising to do, but we are confident we will reach our goal.”

El Segundo Launches New Platform to Promote Aerospace, Hard Tech and AI Growth

The El Segundo Economic Development Corporation has announced Launch Segundo, a new marketing platform designed to elevate the city’s identity as a growing hub for aerospace, defense, hard tech and AI-driven companies.

Built around the message that El Segundo is the city “where big ideas take off,” Launch Segundo will highlight the companies, founders, employers, investors and civic leaders shaping the city’s next phase of economic growth.

According to ESEDC research, approximately 80 new or relocated hard-tech and aerospace startups have established a presence in El Segundo over the last five years. More than 100 startups have also been connected to the city through accelerators

and ecosystem partners such as Starburst.

“Launch Segundo makes sense because it gives us a focused way to tell the story of what El Segundo already is and where we are headed,” said El Segundo Mayor Chris Pimentel. “Our city has an extraordinary business foundation, a growing innovation economy and a community that understands the importance of supporting companies that create jobs, invest locally and strengthen our long-term fiscal health.”

ESEDC points to several factors driving the city’s growth, including the “SpaceX alumni effect,” the national defense-tech venture boom, proximity to Los Angeles Air Force Base, access to engineering talent, industrial zoning and the presence of

by the Cat in the Hat

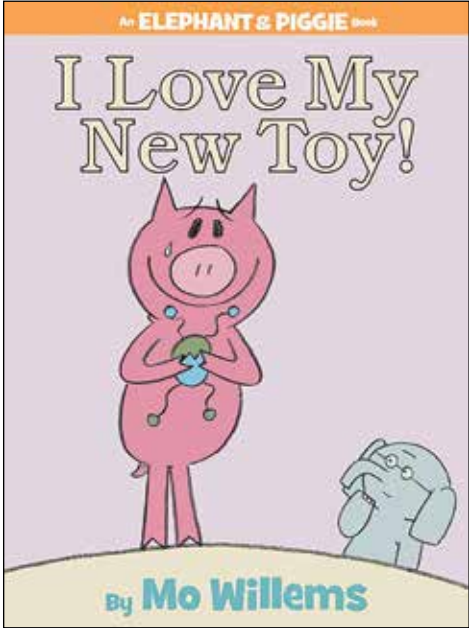

At the end of the story, your book club might have fun discussing what one-of-a-kind ice cream truck would be fun to create.

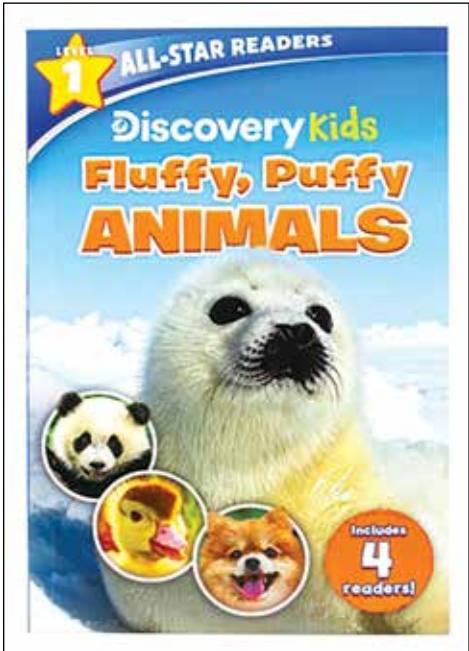
These book kits are the perfect way to start the summer by slowing down, trying something new and getting together with favorite friends.

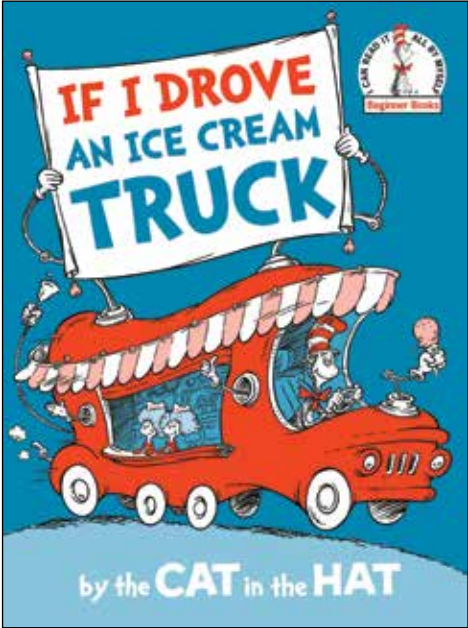

established aerospace and defense companies.

Recent market activity has reinforced El Segundo’s growing national role, including Hermeus’ announcement that it plans to establish a new headquarters in El Segundo following a \$350 million financing round and \$1 billion valuation.

“Launch Segundo is about turning momentum into a sustained narrative,” said Daniel Martin, President of ESEDC. “El Segundo has always been a place where big ideas take off, but what is happening now is different in both scale and speed.”

ESEDC estimates that El Segundo’s hard-tech and aerospace cluster is tied to approximately \$5 billion to \$15 billion or more in cumulative venture and growth capital over the last five

years. The organization also estimates that 3,000 to 8,000 new high-wage jobs have been added to the local hard-tech, aerospace and defense ecosystem during roughly the same period.

Launch Segundo will also highlight El Segundo’s balance of global business relevance and small-town character, including its corporate headquarters, aerospace and defense infrastructure, startup energy, proximity to LAX, coastal lifestyle, walkable downtown and engaged local government.

“El Segundo has the credibility of a global business hub and the character of a true community,” Martin said. “Big ideas have always taken off in El Segundo. Now, Launch Segundo gives us the platform to make sure the world is watching.”

The league crowned winners from the AA, AAA, and Majors divisions in front of several hundred family and friends. To help in the celebration, there was an ice cream truck and huge inflatable slides for the kids to enjoy while mom and dad watched baseball. It couldn't have been a more picturesque day to stage a championship day of Little League baseball. It all took Place at the friendly confines of Brett Field, and the players and fans soaked up the moment.

Giants Win AA Title

The Giants and Yankees were the two top teams based on win-loss records. It was appropriate that these two teams would meet in the championship game to claim bragging rights. In front of an appreciative crowd that numbered in the hundreds. Playing at Brett Field was quite a contrast for the players and their fans. It wasn't the cold evenings playing at Walton Field or Bakalyar Field. No, it was at the well-manicured Brett Field with the fans enjoying real stands to sit in. The Giants scored three first-inning runs, but the Yankees countered with four of their own. The Giants would tag on five second-inning runs and went on to win 12-5.

Ketch McAndrews Leads White Sox to AAA Title

The White Sox were 9-6 during the regular season and caught fire in the playoffs. They defeated the Phillies, Pirates, and Mets to earn their way into the championship game. In the championship game, they faced the Mets. These two teams met three times during the regular season, with the Mets winning two of them. They met in the semi-finals, with the White Sox winning 14-1. The Mets would advance to the championship game with their 12-8 win over the Pirates. In the championship game, the Mets took a 5-1 lead get away, and the White Sox came away with a 16-5 win.

The Mets took an early 5-1 lead into the third inning when the White Sox tied the game. Grant Onishi singled and later in the inning scored on a wild pitch. Lane Graves reached base on an error, and Ketch McAndrews doubled. JR Daly had an RBI double, and Axel Cook's RBI single tied the game at 5-5.

A seven-run fifth inning for the White Sox opened up the game. Brandon Gordon opened the inning with a walk and scored on Lane Graves' double, and he scored on a sacrifice fly by Ketch McAndrews. JR Daly, Axel Cook both singled, and Alex Boger reached on a fielder's choice. Eli Witten's two-run single and Gordon's two-run single made it 12-5. The White Sox would go on to win 16-5.

The White Sox's pitching was too much for the Mets, especially after the second inning. JR Daly came in relief and struck out three after the Mets threatened. Ketch McAndrews tossed an immaculate nine-pitch fourth inning, striking out all three batters. He ended up closing out the game with seven strikeouts in three innings pitched.

Cardinals Use Strong Pitching to Win Majors Championship

The Cardinals spotted the A's a 2-0 lead before putting together a big five-run second inning and holding on for a 5-3 win to claim the Majors championship. It was the strong pitching performance by starter Andrew MacKusick and Liam Bhakta in relief that helped propel the Cardinals to their second championship in three years.

The A's scored two first-inning runs when the first three hitters collected singles. Jagger Debnam, Connor Stuart, and Charlie Barlup each singled. Barlup's RBI single scored Debnam, and Stuart scored on a passed ball to make it 2-0. It was an odd inning

for Cardinals' starter Andrew MacKusick, who struck out four hitters.

The Cardinals threatened to score in the first inning but came away empty. But the momentum wasn't over when they scored five runs in the second inning. Jack Evans led off with a single, followed by Connor Tennant, who singled sharply to left field. Seth Braff's two-run single tied the game at 2-2, and he would score later in the inning on a wild pitch. Trevor Ou singled, and Ryan Bass reached on a walk, and both scored on an error after Luke Haberman's fly ball was misplayed, giving the Cardinals a 5-2 lead.

The A's responded with a run in their half of the third inning when Charlie Barlup, who was three-for-three, hit a triple and scored on a single by Easton Reed. The A's would not threaten the rest of the game and fall 5-3.

The Cardinals' pitching was tough on the A's. After the first inning, Liam Bhakta, who relieved Andrew MacKusick in the second inning, allowed one run, scattered four hits, and struck out ten.

Closing Ceremonies

This season, the ESLL had a record year with 491 athletes spread across 48 teams and 180 volunteers. The snack bar grilled over 1,300 hot dogs and 1,600 hamburgers, as well as 3,200 Red Vines. Forty players who had aged out were introduced, along with the All-Star teams.

Dylan Thomas Joins Select Track Company

El Segundo High School has a superstar track athlete named Dylan Thomas. The junior sprinter made school history this past track season by advancing to the CIF State prelims. He competed against other elite California high school athletes at the California State Track and Field Meet, held in Clovis at Veteran Memorial Stadium.

In the history of the El Segundo High School track program, only five El Segundo athletes have made it to the CIF State Meet. Three made it to the CIF State Meet Finals, and two have now made it as far as the preliminaries.

Here's a rundown of those who made it: 1961 – Mike Bianco, Shot Put, Finals, 3rd Place (18 in total competed); 2001 – Holly Lipscomb, Triple Jump, Preliminaries, 14th Place (nine advanced to Finals); 2008 – Allison Reaser, 300 meter Hurdles, Finals, 6th Place (nine advanced from Preliminaries to Finals)

2010 – Allison Reaser, 300 meter Hurdles, Preliminaries, 10th Place (nine advanced to Finals); 2025 – Kaia Musalborn, Long Jump, Finals, 12th Place (13 advanced from Preliminaries to Finals); 2026 – Dylan Thomas, 100 meter Dash, Preliminaries, 13th Place (nine advanced to Finals) and 2026 – Dylan Thomas, 200 meter Dash, Preliminaries, 24th Place (nine advanced to Finals).

Dylan's track coach, Jessica Davis Sydney, had high praise for her outstanding athlete. "Dylan shows great leadership and displays positive energy towards all of his teammates. He truly put the El Segundo High School Track program on the map, especially when it comes to sprints. Lastly, I always say that great coaches succeed when the administration team has their backs. So a shout out to Mr. Gebhart, Ms. McCann, Mr. Boykins, Mr. Davlantis, and Mrs. Guzman for exemplifying what true leadership is all about." •

The campaign so far has generated \$2.2 million, with CDC, Chevron and Torrance Memorial Medical Center singled out as major contributors plus a number of businesses and residents also kicking in monies towards the effort. With another \$2.8 million to go, it remains to be seen how much more can be filled in to minimize the final impact on the general fund. “Our goal was to raise \$5 million, allowing a cushion for the City,” Sherry Kramer, a board member for SBSHR as well as CDC’s director of community relations (recently retired), said. “Unfortunately, unlike the El Segundo Wiseburn Aquatics Center, we were hopeful businesses large and small would garner more, larger donations. The monies raised for the pool were definitely a result of the generosity of businesses.” She confirmed that while many residents have donated to The Plunge, most did so at \$1,500 or less.” The \$1,500 level or above garners the donor a plaque with their name on it displayed at the site.

Kramer added that SBSHR will continue to raise awareness and monies, while the City takes the lead on marketing efforts. “Richard and the SBSHR board, along with Linda Johnson in our office, will continue to be

involved and support the project,” she said. Compared to the initial timeline of early 2026, The Plunge reopening came about six months late. The delays were the result of change orders due to unforeseen situations, according to Public Works Director Elias Sassoon. “For instance, we had to replace the tiles for both pools when we originally planned to reuse them,” he said. “Also, we had to wait for Southern California Edison’s approval, receive their transformer and make a connection before we could energize The Plunge.”

Other unexpected line items emerged over the past year such as replacing the tiles in both pools, fixing all windows, redoing lighting and addressing much more concrete wall spalling than anticipated. “We also had to install new bleachers when the original plan was to mend the existing bleachers,” Sassoon said.

The Plunge is now open Monday through Saturday, offering a schedule designed to serve a wide range of swimmers. The mornings and evenings focus on lap swimming, while afternoons devote to recreational swim and lessons. Recreation and Parks lists a full, detailed schedule on its social media channels, on its website (earec.org) and at

the facility along with pricing options (\$5 drop-in fee for resident adults and \$3 for seniors, youths and military. Non-residents pay \$3 more).

Sassoon, who visited the site daily over the course of the project, was thrilled with the final product. “The goal was to complete a renovation worthy of a landmark and this has exceeded our expectations,” he said. “The consensus from the El Segundo community was strong: reinvest in this local institution. So we retained the iconic imagery and design, restoring the facade and saving original features like the ‘fish tiles’ that will be on display. At the same time, we had a mandate to modernize the function of the facility. The Plunge was state-of-the-art when it opened in the 1940s; and at its reopening, it is once again a model community asset. We’ve worked to replace nearly every component of the pool equipment and even made sure that the Internet is fully accessible in the facility. This moment marks the rebirth of an amenity that has served El Segundo for generations and will now continue to be a center of our community for at least 50 years more.”

Sassoon also credited key supporters and staff that made the project possible, including

the Aquatics Committee of the Recreation and Parks Commission and the Commission itself; the City Council; City Manager; Mancini and her staff (particularly Recreation Manager Linnea Palmer and Aquatics Manager Joseph Lormans); and Recreation Supervisor Jorge Prado, who is also a registered pool mechanic. “Lastly, I would like to recognize the outstanding work by City Engineer Cheryl Ebert, who served as the project manager on this project,” Sassoon said.

As The Plunge moves forward into a new era, Mancini made it a point last Saturday to acknowledge the man whose name is prominently displayed on the front of the building. While researching the facility before the reopening, she came to a heartwarming realization. “What really touched me was how many people spoke to me about how Mr. Saari made them feel and [him] making sure they understood that all he ever wanted from any of his athletes and any of the people he trained was to give their best,” she said. “It was so apparent as I was doing the research that his kindness and leadership truly changed the lives of thousands and thousands of young people that came into this building...” •

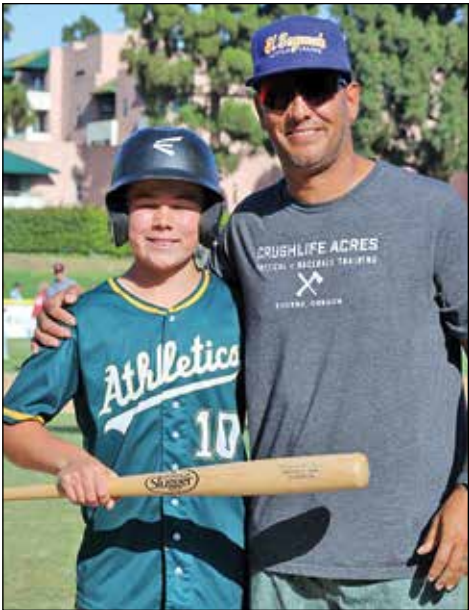

- **Step 2:** Stir the onion and stock in a roasting pan. Place the pork in the roasting pan. Cover the pan tightly with aluminum foil.
- **Step 3:** Roast for 3 hours or until the pork is fork-tender. Uncover and let stand for 30 minutes. Spoon off any fat. Do not discard the cooking liquid.
- **Step 4:** Heat the ketchup, vinegar, molasses, reserved brown sugar mixture and 1 cup cooking liquid in a 2-quart saucepan over medium-high heat to a boil. Reduce the heat to medium-low. Cook for 25 minutes or until the sauce is slightly thickened, stirring occasionally.
- **Step 5:** Remove the pork to a cutting board. Using 2 forks, shred the pork. Place the shredded pork into a large bowl. Pour the remaining cooking liquid over the pork. Add half the sauce and toss to coat (add more sauce if you like until desired consistency). Divide the pork mixture among the buns. Serve any remaining sauce on the side.

Serving Suggestion: For a nice balance of flavor and texture, try topping the sliders with coleslaw.

2025 City of El Segundo Urban Water Management Plan Update: Public Notice

The Urban Water Management Planning Act (formerly AB 797) and the 1990 Amendment (formerly AB 2661), now adopted in the California Water Code § 10610 - 10657, require all urban water suppliers who provide water to more than 3,000 customers, to prepare and adopt an Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP) every five years. Our last plan was adopted in 2020/2021 and the requirements of the UWMP Act have not changed since 2020; only definitions have been added or modified. The 2025 plan, which includes data through the end of 2025,

is required to be adopted by July 2026. As mandated, the City of El Segundo, in coordination with the West Basin Municipal Water District (WBMWD), is making the draft 2025 Plan available for public review in late June 2026. Any interested parties can request information or leave comments with the City's Public Works Department by contacting Cheryl Ebert, City Engineer, at 310-524-2321 or via email to cebert@elsegundo.org. Since the original act's passage in 1983, several amendments have been added. One of the most recent changes includes legislative requirements set forth by SBX7-7 or the 20x2020 Water Conservation Plan, which calls for a 20

percent per capita water use reduction by the year 2020. The inclusion of Section SBX7-7 in the 2025 UWMP is to allow the City to report on progress towards meeting the urban water use targets. The City's reduced water use targets were introduced in the 2010 UWMP and met in the 2020 and 2025 Plan updates. The City is currently in compliance with SBX7-7 requirements. A public hearing will be held in August 2026 to present the final plan to City Council and allow for public comment on the Plan update. The date of the hearing is to be determined.
