ESPD Sees Progress in Addressing E-Bike Issues

Some are careful to abide by the rules of the road. Others like to pull wheelies on a hill along Grand Avenue at night to the horror of unsuspecting drivers. Electric bikes (e-bikes) seem to be everywhere and remain a cause for concern. But despite an overall increase in complaints since 2022, El Segundo Police Department (ESPD) Lieutenant Cory McEnroe maintains that the issue “has steadily become less of a problem” due to a proactive three-pronged approach of education, awareness, and enforcement that has paid dividends. “Our traffic division has a significant role,” he said of the effort. “However, this is a community issue and our partnership with the community, school district, and City leaders is the most important component to addressing this issue and reducing the opportunity for it to escalate.”

In 2022, ESPD launched local outreach on e-bikes through social media posts and pamphlets. The department also provided educational information at booths during community events and contracted with E-Bike Sense to offer a course teaching safety steps to riders and parents. The course includes a classroom portion to go over traffic laws plus a practical segment for safe usage and operation. ESPD continues to deploy officers in multiple saturation patrol details around town to focus on violators.

Despite the progress noted above, Lt. McEnroe cautioned that addressing e-bike misuse remains an ongoing challenge and requires constant monitoring. The latest ESPD statistics for the past year showed 74 total calls (19 in the last quarter of 2024 and 55 this year through August) for requested police response to complaints about e-bikes—predominantly for reckless riding. Lt. McEnroe noted there was an uptick in calls this summer due to juveniles riding e-bikes at Recreation Park.

E-bike violations were also a top complaint among residents and business owners along Grand and on Main Street.

Meanwhile, ESPD reported four e-bike-related crashes and one minor injury over the past 12 months—a key area that has seen a decrease. While El Segundo experienced one seriously crash involving a rider since e-bikes became popular, other South Bay cities were worse off, with multiple fatal crashes and major injuries in recent years. Given the potential dangers, ESPD partners with the Manhattan Beach, Hermosa Beach, and Redondo Beach PDs to conduct directed e-bike enforcement operations within each of the cities. “We also hold regular meetings with all the South Bay traffic divisions to discuss traffic-related problems we are having and other areas of concern,” Lt. McEnroe said.

ESPD issued 23 e-bike-related citations in 2024 and another 18 so far this year. “Keep in mind we generally do not issue citations, especially for juveniles,” Lt. McEnroe said. “Instead, we call their parents and inform them of the violation. I believe that parents are more aware now of the dangers of e-bikes and are either not buying them for their children or making sure they are riding safely and obeying the rules of the road than in the past when e-bikes first spiked in popularity.”

Lt. McEnroe confirmed to no one’s surprise that the top e-bike offenders are minors who violate traffic rules and ride unsafely. Wheelies in the roadway around pedestrians, as well as other vehicular traffic, and stop sign violations are most common. “We also see violations due to riding in prohibited

City’s Flag Action Questioned; Chevron Awards Large Grant

Surfing in the Olympics, a flag flown at half-staff by the government of the City of El Segundo after President Trump ordered U.S. flags to be flown at half-staff on federal buildings, grounds, and facilities to honor Arizona resident and founder of Turning Point USA, and a grant from Chevron were all remarked upon at the City Council meeting Tuesday night. Other agenda items included a review of the city’s budget as it approaches the end of the fourth quarter and fiscal year, and Hyperion, which received 69 odor complaints since the last council meeting, with two Notices of Violation issued by the South Coast Air Quality District.

As is typical of El Segundo City Council meetings, the city read three proclamations near the beginning of its meeting: one on October being Breast Cancer Awareness Month, another for the International Day of Peace observed worldwide annually on September 21, and another one in recognition of Hispanic/Latin Heritage Month from September 15 to October 15. Council member Michelle Keldorf accepted the Breast Cancer Awareness proclamation, as no one else was present to do so, while other individuals accepted the International Day of Peace proclamation. Resident and member of the city’s Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Committee Sean O’Brien,

himself of Hispanic/Latin roots, delivered remarks on the importance of the Hispanic/Latin population. He noted that nearly one in every five Americans (more than 62 million people) identifies as Hispanic or Latino, and discussed the significant contributions they have made and continue to make. When he mentioned "a harder reality" and ICE raids, Mayor Chris Pimentel interrupted him, saying it was not the time for such a comment, calling it "political". O'Brien then returned to make comments during the official Public Comment portion of the meeting.

When that official commenting time began, Kelly Stewart took to the podium and microphone to address how the City of El Segundo had been flying the American flag at half-staff. She said, "OK, so, I learned on the 12th that the City of El Segundo had chosen to honor Charlie Kirk at the behest of the Trump administration by lowering flags to half staff. I would like to believe that whoever made that decision is ignorant of who Kirk actually was and doesn't understand what kind of message the city is sending to its own residents. The murder of Charlie Kirk was a horrible atrocity, and any acceptance or celebration of it dehumanizes us all. However, an official government mourning of Kirk is inappropriate. Charlie Kirk was not just a young man who debated people at college campuses. He was the leader of a \$100-million organization, Turning Point USA, which has been profiled for its hate speech by the Anti-Defamation League and had been designated a hate group by the Southern Poverty Law Center. His debates were not meant to share ideas. They were meant to exploit unprepared college students and create viral clips dunking on them that were used to incite outrage for culture wars." She then listed things Kirk has said. "By honoring Charlie Kirk and by blindly following an order set out by the Trump administration, the City of El Segundo appears to endorse these beliefs. The murder of Charlie Kirk is being weaponized to accelerate and justify attacks on trans people, gay people, black people, immigrants, and anyone who resists or speaks out against the Trump administration. It seems we are in a new McCarthyism." She then talked about a vigil held in Huntington Beach for Kirk and how "neo nazis" along with members of "patriot" [ineligible] beat up a man, later claiming he was Antifa. The man was actually a Trump supporter, she said. "I want my city officials to stand between an administration that is preparing to target its most vulnerable citizens." Stewart then told the city council how her grandson told her some kids were "happy" at

Kirk's death, and she thought that was horrible and asked her grandson, "Why?" She said "kids" felt "dehumanized" by Kirk's shrugging off school shootings and his preaching of hatred toward LGBTQ+ individuals. "So, I want us to think before we act, before we just like openly follow, ya know, I mean, I understand this was like an order, and you guys did what is like normally done, but things aren't normal. That's what I want you guys to understand. I sincerely like, kind of, beg you. Think and research before. You know, you guys have to learn about extremism because we are in a very dangerous time."

When O'Brien reappeared at the podium to make his public comment, he told the council that he "wasn't trying to make that into a political moment..."

After Public Comment, in response to the flag comments, City Manager Darrell George said, "Yeah, just that as the speaker shared, yes, that was a declaration from the President declaring staff that flags be flown at half staff and we honored that directive." Said Mayor Chris Pimentel, "OK. Uh, maybe where the discussion, at some later date, of do we have a methodology around it?" He then noted how quickly such directives happen and the lack of time for a special meeting, but that it could be a future subject.

In other news, Chevron gave the city \$75,000 in grant money to support economic development. In addition, city staff noted that Chevron, to date, had contributed \$1.5 million historically for economic development. Jessica Vincent of Chevron told council the grant has an application and review process and "I'm thrilled that year after year, that Chevron does award this to to the City of El Segundo, recognizing that this program really does help businesses thrive, and definitely, in my opinion, this is a program where we collaborate and it really enhances the quality of life for residents, visitors, and businesses alike."

In surfing news, council member Drew Boyles announced that he and the mayor had written a letter to support USA Surfing's recertification as the national governing body for Olympic surfing. In his remarks, Boyles stated that the U.S. Ski and Snowboard Association is attempting to become the governing body for the 2028 Olympics, citing its representation of parallel sports and its superior equipment. Boyles said, "But it's really a money grab." On a 5-0 vote, the council approved a resolution in support. Boyles had noted that El Segundo is the headquarters of the World Surf League. He also noted the city's strong ties to surfing. •

Eagle Teams Off to Strong Program Start

The El Segundo High School's football and girls' volleyball teams are off to their program's best start in years. The flag football team looks to have plenty of potential, while the boys' water polo start has played an arduous schedule.

Eagles Fly Past South Torrance 44-14

The Eagles scored three first-quarter touchdowns and went on to collect their fourth consecutive win to start the season. This time it was a 44-14 win over the South Torrance Spartans.

The Eagles scored on their first four possessions. Junior quarterback scrambled for a 42-yard touchdown run, slicing through the Spartan secondary on his way to his fourth rushing touchdown of the season.

On their next possession, the Eagles went 69 yards in seven rushing plays to score a touchdown. Senior running back Isaiah Rodriguez carried the load, rushing five times for 36 yards, including a three-yard plunge into the end zone for a 14-6 lead. On their next possession, the Eagles capitalized on their midfield starting position. On the third play of the possession, Wiacek connected with senior wide receiver Spencer Osborne on a 50-yard catch and run for a touchdown and a 20-6 lead.

In the second quarter, the Eagles extended their lead on a long touchdown pass from Wiacek to Axel Theiss with 8:04 remaining in the first half. El Segundo's defense came up big on the Spartans' twelve-play drive that stalled on the Eagles' 10-yard line. The El Segundo offense took over and Wiacek

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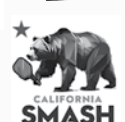

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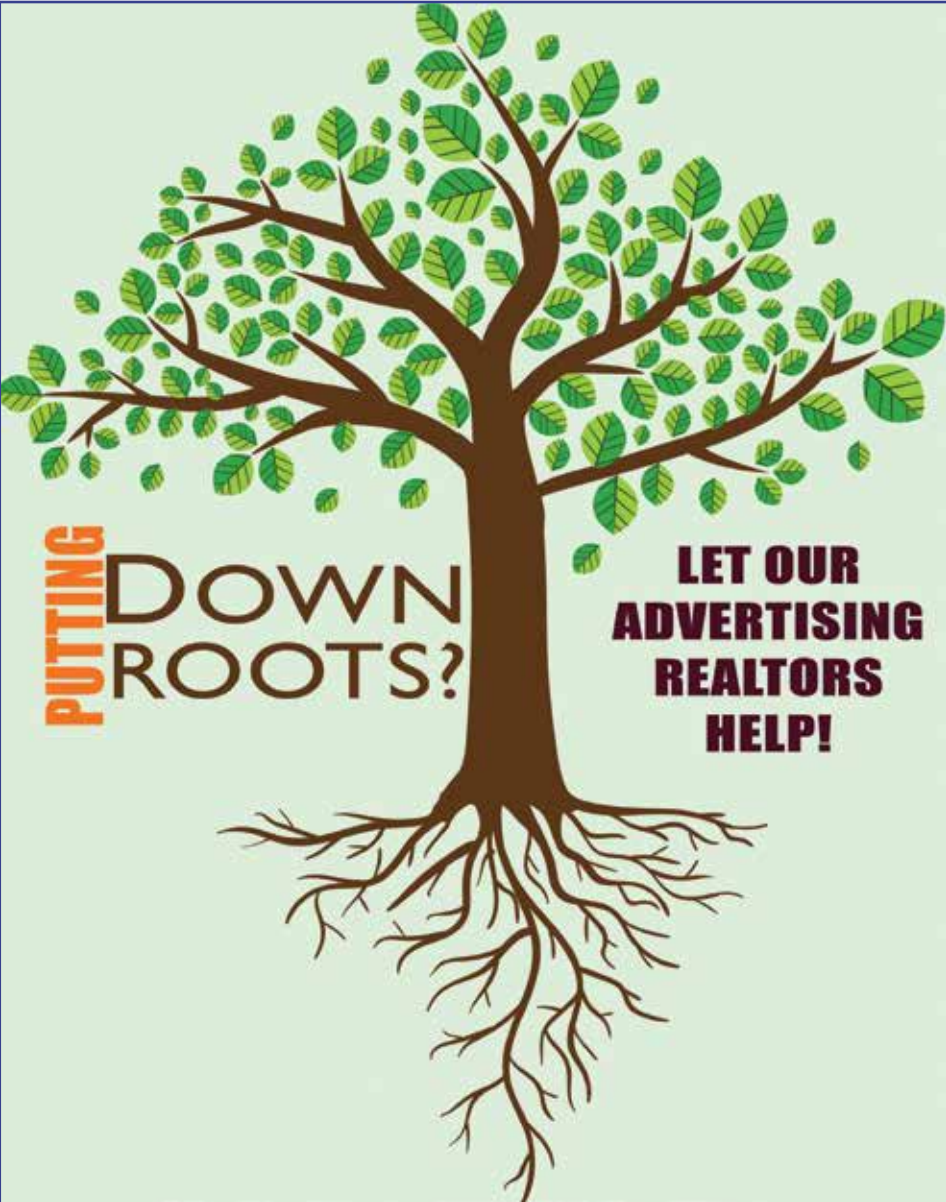

areas like any of our parks,” he said. “It is unlawful to ride an e-bike on any portion of any park within El Segundo.”

Another major violation is the use of illegal off-road electric dirt bikes such as Sur-Ron, Talaria, and Attis Sigma. “We also have issues with modified e-bikes that look like Class 1 or 2 e-bikes, but by cutting a wire or adding a more powerful motor, can go up to 60 miles per hour,” Lt. McEnroe said. “The vast majority of unsafe e-bike riding that involves wheelies is on these modified e-bikes—especially on the illegal electric dirt bikes. These modifications are often done without the parents even knowing.” To combat this, the department encourages parents to periodically ride their children’s e-bikes to ensure the speed remains within the prescribed limits: 20 miles per hour for Class 1 or 2 e-bikes and 28 miles per hour for Class 3s.

One of the inherent problems with e-bikes is that there is no minimum age to ride a Class 1 or Class 2 vehicle. Class 3 riders must be at least 16 years of age. “All riders of Class 3 e-bikes must also wear a helmet, regardless of age,” Lt. McEnroe added. “Riders under 18 who ride any bicycle, including Class 1 and Class 2 e-bikes, must wear helmets.”

Costs for citations (when administered) depend on the courthouse. However, ESPD officers have discretion to refer any violators to its diversion program. “If the violator successfully completes an e-bike safety course within a predetermined timeframe, the citation is cancelled,” Lt. McEnroe said.

While riders do not have to register their e-bikes, ESPD encourages them to do so. “This helps us with locating owners in the

event we find a bicycle or recover one that was stolen,” Lt. McEnroe explained. To further address this, the department partnered with El Segundo Unified School District (and in particular El Segundo Middle School) to require students wishing to park their e-bikes on campus to first register. “To register the e-bike, the student must attend an e-bike training course,” Lt. McEnroe said. “When the student attends the course, an officer inspects the bicycle and lets the parent know if there are any obvious issues. Upon completion of the course, the school will give the student a registration sticker to place on their e-bike. Since implementing this program last school year, our e-bike complaints and e-bike-related traffic crashes have gone down dramatically.”

Lt. McEnroe hopes the ongoing outreach and collaborative approach will continue to make inroads. For those thinking about obtaining an e-bike and existing riders, he offered a few words of advice. “Use common sense and obey the rules of the road,” he emphasized. “Also, avoid riding in the lanes of traffic, when possible, especially on busy roadways like PCH, Imperial Highway, and Vista del Mar. Regardless, if the cyclist is not at fault or not for a traffic crash, the cyclist is usually the one who suffers the most significant injuries.” He also cautioned parents not to purchase e-bikes for their kids until they are absolutely sure those youngsters are mature enough to ride responsibly. “And lastly, if you witness unsafe e-bike riding, call ESPD or their local law enforcement agency. Know that all the South Bay agencies take these violations very seriously...” •

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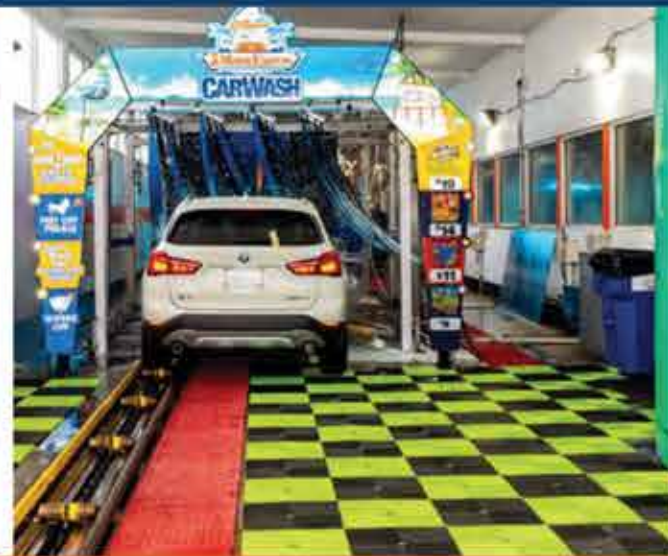
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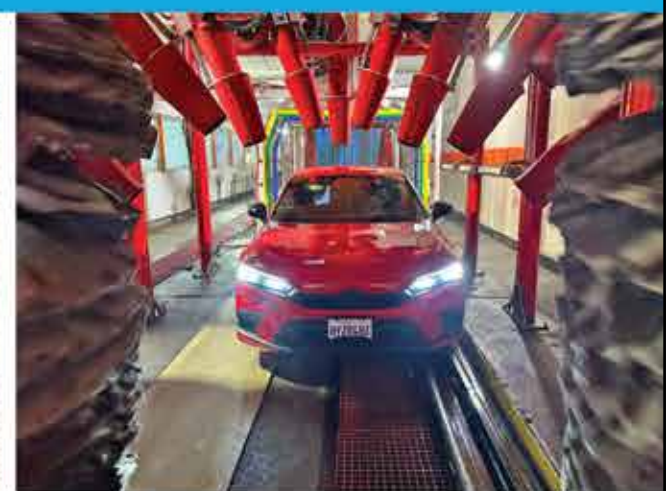
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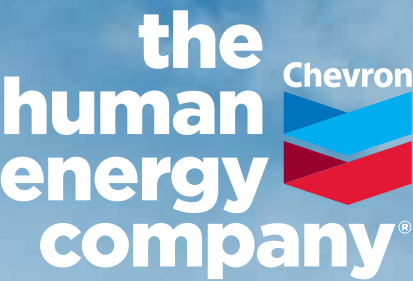


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
