Park Vista Remains Housing Haven for Seniors

When Judy Scott moved into El Segundo's Park Vista senior housing complex four years ago, COVID-19 restrictions were still in place, with common areas closed and residents mostly confined to their apartments. Even when things "opened up" as the pandemic's impact faded, many were still hesitant to come out and mingle. Scott quickly became part of the residents' committee that organized events for the tenants, and she joined the social hour group, which met on Fridays at 4:30 p.m. A July 4 potluck was an early breakthrough—drawing about 25 residents. Additional events followed over the next couple of years, celebrating holidays and other milestones as participation continued to increase. Then, on August 23, Park Vista celebrated its 38th anniversary with catered food, a photo booth, and a DJ to entertain 120 people. Scott and anniversary party planning committee member Jo Ann McDonough also collected 40 gift cards from area businesses to donate to residents via a raffle drawing. With more activities on the horizon, the goal is to maintain the momentum.

A treasured community mainstay, Park Vista originally opened in 1987. A few years prior to that, the City of El Segundo became subject to the provisions of Proposition 4 (also known as the "Gann Limit"). The legislation required state and local governments to return any funds to taxpayers in excess of the amount appropriated for a given fiscal year. The City reported a surplus in collections in one of the early '80s years, and residents requested that the excess funds be spent on low-income, independent housing for seniors. "Park Vista was created by pioneering community members such as Peter and Edna Freeman, Chris Sherrill and others who wanted the City to provide an affordable option to El Segundo residents to live in a senior facility to honor and protect the legacy of our

El Segundo community members," said Neil Cadman, whose company Cadman Group has managed Park Vista on behalf of the El Segundo Senior Citizen Housing Corporation since 2008. "It is not a HUD low-income or designated 'affordable' property, but rather the City has designed the building to provide housing to ensure our aging population has an option to remain in El Segundo."

Located adjacent to Recreation Park at 615 E. Holly Avenue, the 97-unit facility features an on-site laundry room, exercise room, community lounge, secure building access, two elevators, reading nook, and outdoor patio overlooking the park. "We have the best view in town of the annual fireworks show," said Scott.

Park Vista consists of a five-story and a four-story wing, featuring 33 studio apartments,

63 one-bedroom units, and three different floor plans. One apartment has two bedrooms. All include a patio or balcony. Over the past five years, 15 units have undergone renovations with new cabinets, flooring, and fixtures. "Additionally, broilers and HVAC units have been replaced, major servicing to elevators has occurred, and intermittent upgrades and servicing to plumbing throughout the facility have been repaired," noted City of El Segundo Community Development Director Michael Allen.

Allen explained that the City owns Park Vista and is "100 percent responsible" for its operation and maintenance, with funding culled from monthly rent revenues. "Any major work that might arise, that exceeds the revenue the facility generates or exceeds our savings,

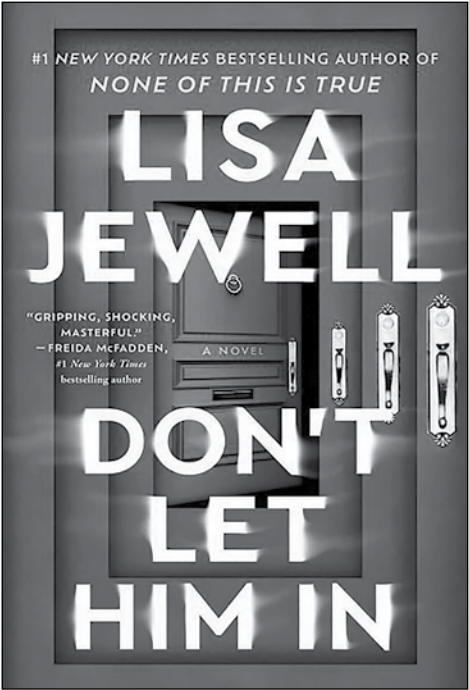

Predators Review: Good vs Evil Isn't so Black and White

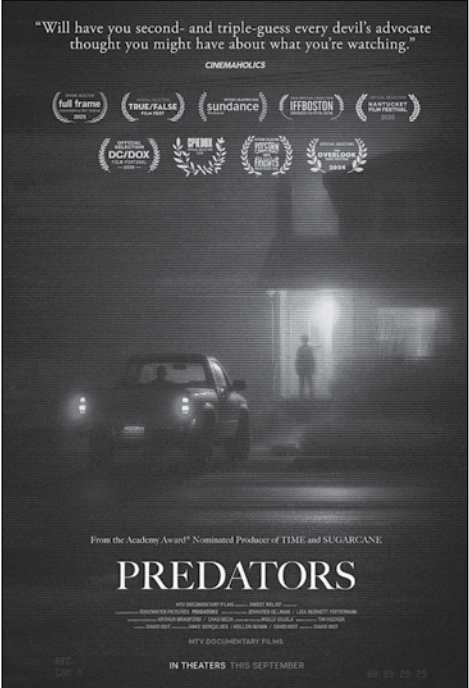

We've all been there, eyes glued to our screens, watching the latest car chase through the streets of Los Angeles. Or maybe your vice is scrolling late-night TikToks of police body cam footage catching Target shoplifters. There is no denying that this type of voyeuristic content is entertaining, sometimes embarrassingly so. The question is, why are we so drawn to watching people at their worst, especially when it comes to true crime? In the documentary *Predators*, filmmaker David Osit explores the psychological fascination behind the popular TV show *To Catch a Predator*, and how the series continues to perpetuate the blurred lines between

justice and entertainment. Now playing in select theaters.

Since its inception in the early 2000s, Dateline NBC's *To Catch a Predator* series became an instant cultural phenomenon. The show employed decoys, actors pretending to be young teenagers, to lure child predators to a sting house, which is actually a film set. The men arrive thinking that they are meeting up with their underage victim. What they don't expect is for Chris Hansen to appear with a film crew and catch them in the act. Hansen typically asks the men, "What are you doing here?", and there is never a reassuring answer. Famously, Hansen ends his interviews by saying, "You're free to leave." It is then that these men are apprehended by local law enforcement and taken to jail. Typically, the episode ends there, and those watching from home turn to another program. But for these offenders, their nightmare is just starting.

Water Polo Eagles Finish Second in South Bay Tournament

There is no doubt that *To Catch a Predator* is a stunning candid-camera investigative series. However, the show has never been explored from the psychological standpoint of our obsession with watching people at their lowest. Director David Osit's very personal motivation to explore the morally gray ethics of *To Catch a Predator* opens our eyes to points of view that offer incredibly thought-provoking testimony. Speaking with former decoys, law enforcement, and Chris Hansen himself, Osit crafts a delicate story of how good vs evil isn't always so black and white.

Says Osit, "Ultimately, I couldn't have imagined the depths of the journey I'd end up going on - how making this film would not only challenge the limits of my own empathy, but reflect the tenuous morality behind how we tell stories, report news, and make films. My frustration with true crime, I realized, came from the illusion that after

watching a true crime story, the crime will be solved and we'll get all the answers. But what if I made a film that was about what happens - and what are we capable of doing to each other - when answers can't be found? In a sense, *Predators* became a true crime story. But the villain wasn't who I thought it'd be."

Predators is a tough watch, and you may not agree with some of the statements made on screen. But Osit doesn't aim to change your mind about the show's impact or importance. Instead, *Predators* is more of a vehicle for self-reflection. It leads us to question why we embrace this type of content so voraciously. Further, it challenges us to examine this uncomfortable topic in order to find humanity in its complexity.

Once the credits roll, we're free to leave the theater. But the emotional impact of *Predators* will linger with you long after. •

But where he has made defenses play honest is his knack for running the ball. He has rushed for 517 yards and four touchdowns to lead the offense.

As good as Wiacek has been rushing the ball, the Eagles have three others who have punished the opposition. Brian Everitt leads

the team in rushing attempts while averaging five yards per carry and four touchdowns. Isaiah Rodriguez has been a key part of the offense. He brings a rugged running style that has baffled defenses on his way to averaging 6.2 yards per carry. Then there's Lincoln Quaintance, who has rushed for 184 yards on just 21 carries or an eye-popping 8.1 yards per attempt.

As good as the ground game has been, Wiacek has proven receivers he trusts. Axel Theiss leads the team with twenty receptions for 399 yards and three TDs. Spencer Osborne is another sure-handed receiver who has developed into an offensive threat. His 237 yards and four touchdowns are impressive on just eight receptions. Chase Mattoon gives the Eagles another option with great hands. The junior wide-out has three touchdowns, but it's his big play capabilities that have

extended possessions.

Defensively, the Eagles are solid. Defensive end Hunter Sprick has been a handful for the opposition's quarterback; he has a team-leading six sacks. Isaiah Rodriguez has been active on defense when he's not rushing the ball. The senior linebacker leads the team in tackles, including three sacks. Spencer Osborne leads the secondary in intercepting pass plays as well as being in on thirty-one defensive plays. Charles Juarez is just a sophomore, but he is a two-year starter and for good reason. His knack for being around the ball is impressive, and his twenty-one solo tackles lead the team.

The Eagles start their Ocean League schedule Friday at 7 p.m. on the road when they take on the Hawthorne Cougars. The Eagles return home next Friday at 7 p.m. when they host the Beverly Hills Normans. •

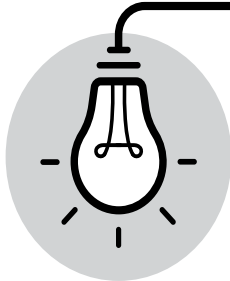

would be paid out of the City’s general fund.”

To prepare for future repair costs, the City conducts a facility assessment about every five years. “We annually audit needed reports and changes, and budgets accordingly,” said Allen. “Some of the upcoming work may include future unit improvements as tenancy turns over and parking lot paving.”

The City contracts with Cadman Group to handle day-to-day managerial tasks, including leasing, collecting rent, paying bills, developing and overseeing the budget, and performing maintenance for tenants. “We are most proud of providing exceptional services for our valued El Segundo senior citizens,” said Cadman. With Park Vista nearing 40 years, the ongoing challenge is maintaining the building in good working order. “Plumbing, roof, hot water systems, etc., are all aging, and we work with the El Segundo Public Works Department to make sure the facility meets our valued tenants’ needs.”

Park Vista remains a highly in-demand living destination. As of last count, 86 individuals were on the waiting list, with the earliest signing up back in 2018. Indeed, patience is a virtue in this case. “Individuals who are at the top of the list have a one-time bypass in the event they are not ready to move in yet but wish to remain on the list,” said Allen. “If they bypass a subsequent time, they are moved to the bottom of the list.”

Cadman explained that rents for newly vacated apartments are at 60 percent of El Segundo’s market value. “Park Vista is a unique building in El Segundo providing more amenities than any other current multi-family building, so the comparison of rents is challenging...but with 35 years of experience owning and operating multi-family property in Southern California, we are effective in achieving a fair market value,” he said. “That rate is set by the City of El Segundo and the City Council.”

Prospective tenants must be at least 62 years old—though a previous roommate, spouse, or significant other as young as 55 can live with the applicant. Candidates must also be current residents of El Segundo or have lived in the town continuously for at least five years. Financial eligibility depends on a formula that calculates a combination of annual income and a percentage of net asset value. Park Vista is not an assisted living facility; however, tenants can hire their own caregivers to assist with health issues.

Back in ‘87, when Park Vista started out, the initial tenants scored their apartments by putting their names in a big bowl for a drawing to determine who got first dibs. The original residents who eventually stayed for many years called themselves The Pioneers. Sadly, none of those individuals is still with us. However, the longest-standing current tenant, Elenia Garza, moved to Park Vista in the early ‘90s. She is now 103 years old and is, in Scott’s words, “amazing.”

Meanwhile, Denice Landucci has the distinction of being a second-generation resident. She arrived at Park Vista 21 years ago, but her mother, Marjorie O’Neil, was one of “The Pioneers”. She visited her mom often back then and remembers seeing the happy tenants hanging out at barbecues and playing card games. Scott hopes to see that social spirit revive and thrive. She added that Park Vista is a haven that saved her from potential hardship. “It has allowed me to remain residing in El Segundo, where I have lived for the past 37 years,” she said. “My rent had gone sky-high, and I would have been homeless if I remained at my prior location. I love living at the park and hope Park Vista remains affordable, as this was the way it was designed for people on fixed incomes.” •

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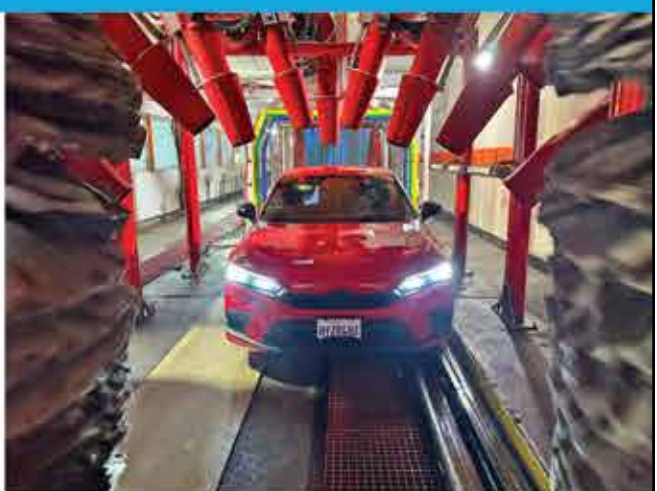
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
