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Students Create Book to Bring Awareness to the Blue Butterfly

What Happened to the El Segundo Blue Butterflies?

Cara King and Sarah Spraggins are both Seniors at El Segundo High School and Interns for the El Segundo Blue Butterfly Conservancy. They have been helping grow the native habitat and increase awareness of the El Segundo Blue Butterfly here in town. For the past couple of months, they have devoted their time and talents to developing an illustrated children's book about this endangered species. The book, called "El Segundo's Little Secret... What Happened to the Blues?", was funded by the City of El Segundo Cultural Development Program and will be available soon. This generous grant covered the production of 1000 paperback books, some which will be donated to El Segundo schools, library, and Chamber of Commerce.

In the spring of 2024, El Segundo Blue Butterfly Conservancy, a 501(c)3 non-profit conservation group, began planting Sea Cliff Buckwheat and other native pollinator plants in the sand dunes along Memory Park on West Imperial Ave. More than a quarter of an acre has been planted and is currently being maintained. We should see the butterflies in this location in summer 2026! The Conservancy is grateful to all our volunteers that have assisted with the hillside, including Eagle Scouts, Beachside National Charity League, Girl Scouts, Rotary, and Chevron.

This book, with its vibrant text and joyful illustrations, will help educate children about this endangered butterfly (Euphilotes allyni), the tiny mascot of El Segundo. Books will be available for a \$15 donation to the El Segundo Blue Butterfly Conservancy. The

proceeds will be used for continued education on the endangered butterfly, and planting and maintenance of the West Imperial Ave. hillside, to ensure the long-term survival of the butterfly.

A Leap for Columbia Memorial Space Center

The Columbia Memorial Space Center is regarded as one of the best space museums in the country. While it certainly is one of the most kid-friendly, the two-story building in Downey is also sacred ground because it honors the memory of a second, less-talked-about disaster for a NASA space shuttle and its crew.

The Columbia orbiter carrying seven crew members disintegrated on Feb. 1, 2003, on re-entry from a 17-day science mission. The mission ended tragically 15 minutes before the crew was due to land at Kennedy Space Center in Florida. Damage to the shuttle's wing, which occurred during liftoff, caused

the breach, according to an investigation that followed the accident and shut down the shuttle program for two years.

Downey last month broke ground on a major expansion at the nation's memorial for the Columbia, which was the second and last time American astronauts died during the Space Shuttle program. A plaque on the second floor of the museum honors astronauts Rick Husband, William McCool, Michael Anderson, David Brown, Kalpana Chawla, Lauren Salton Clark, and Ilan Ramon.

Go and experience it if you have a chance. It's a national monument hiding in plain

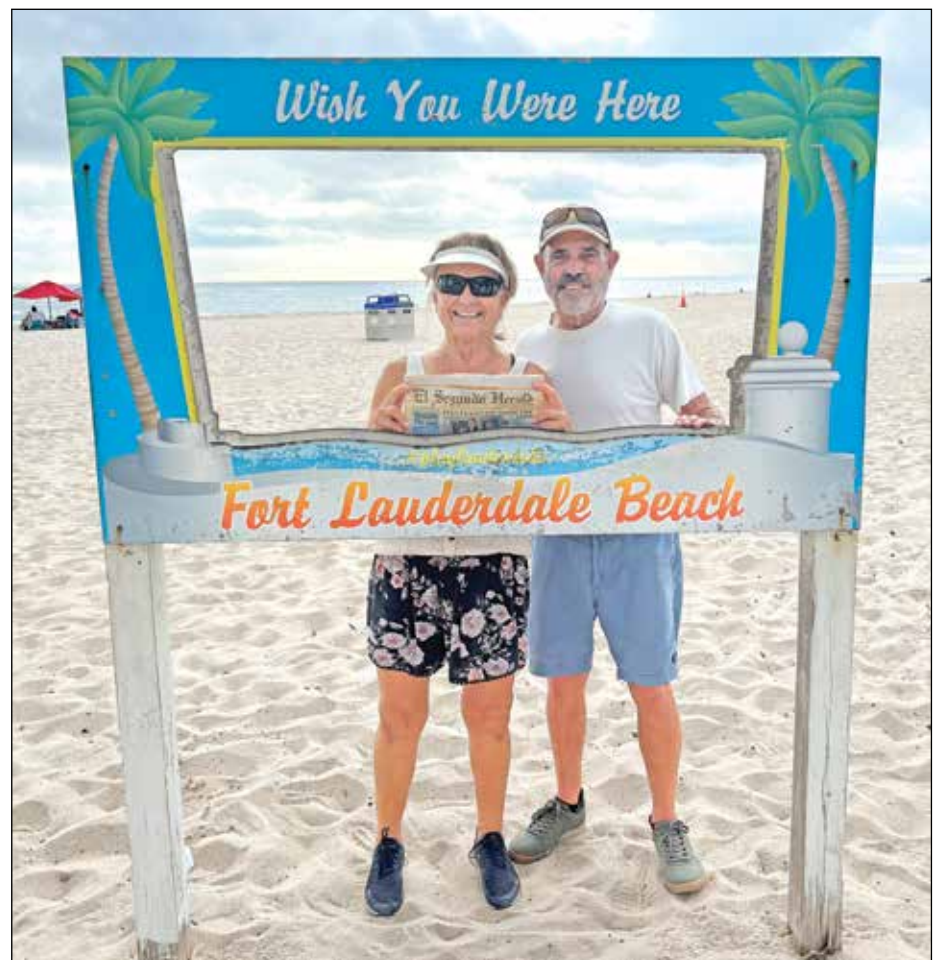

An Overview of the El Segundo Soccer Teams

Over the past several seasons, the El Segundo High School's boys' and girls' soccer teams have enjoyed phenomenal success. The boys team won back-to-back CIF championships and was in the mix for several league championships. The girls' team has been just as successful, having advanced to consecutive Southern California Regional tournaments. Their success has been noticed by opponents, who regard them as elite programs in the South Bay.

Eagles Have Experience to Thrive

The Eagles' continued success had landed them in the South Bay's elite league, the Bay League. Having enjoyed success in the Pioneer League, they were inserted into the Bay League, where each game is like a playoff game.

Head coach Andrew Kelley has been at the helm for the past seventeen years. He has built his successful program on talent, commitment, and a willingness to improve. He is as knowledgeable a coach as you will find and is committed to teaching soccer the right way. He has prepared his team in the same manner for the past several seasons, which has spelled success. They held tryouts a little bit earlier than usual so that they could get the team sorted. "We only lost a handful of seniors who played regularly for us, so we didn't have big gaps to fill. We've been just trying to have the boys train together

to start to build on those connections and relationships on the pitch."

Though the experience should translate into a fun and winning season, there are three key players who should lead the team. Max Abroms, Brad Haug, and Bryant Waites are key players. Still, their philosophy is always to focus on the collective team. "Those three boys kind of formed the spine of the team from the center of defense through midfield to attack. But, anybody on any given day can lift the team up and do something special."

The Eagles have anything but an easy schedule building up to their Bay League tilt. They have had three consecutive seasons with double-digit wins, averaging 14 wins per season. This season, they started by hosting City Section power Eastside (Southgate), who won 21 games last season. Yesterday, they played another City Section power, the Roosevelt Roughriders, and host South Bay powerhouse West Torrance next Tuesday, December 9, at 3:30 p.m. And to finish off December, they'll participate in the South Torrance Holiday Tournament.

The coaching staff is high on this year's team. "We are really looking forward to this year because we have a group that has played together for a few seasons now. We believe that they have the experience, talent, and grit to go far. It's a delightful group of athletes to be around. They are always positive and backing each other up, and they know when to push each other when that time comes."

Lady Eagles Look to Have a Great Season

The Eagles have the formula for a successful season, even if they lost fourteen players to graduation. Head coach Rob Duffy, in his third season directing the Eagles, believes the returning players, with their experience, will make this season a positive one. He says the team will build around the gifted soccer players returning.

Of course, it takes months of preparation to build a successful team, and Coach Duffy has done so methodically. He believes in team unity and keeping players together. So, team members attend community events and training together. The team regularly trained at Gate 14 Fitness Center leading up to the season. There, they worked on strength, endurance, and fitness to cope with the rigors of playing soccer at a high level. Their recent workouts, to prepare for the season, included field time when available and individual time to work on drills.

The Eagles have a young team that has experience. Those being counted on to lead this year's version of the Eagles are Jo Topar, Emma Rubio, Rosa Luaraca, and Kailey Keith. Topar is a senior with three years of experience with the varsity. She steps into a mentoring role, helping the younger players.

This will be an opportunity for the four standout sophomores to show off their potential. Rubio, Luaraca, Audrey Camarillo, and Layla Gomez have demonstrated their athleticism and high soccer IQ. Each had significant playing

time as a freshman. Kailey Keith, a junior, has developed into one of the team's leaders and will help the motivation factor with her completeness.

Others who give the Eagles depth are Rebecca Rodriguez and Quinn Ramirez. Each has a unique quality and set of skills to bring to the lineup.

The Eagles will play a rigorous non-league schedule, including matches against Division 1 powers Torrance, Mira Costa, and Redondo early in the season. The Pioneer League slate is another gauntlet they will need to face when that part of the schedule rolls around. The Eagles placed second behind the South Torrance Spartans a year ago, and the Spartans are a favorite to repeat. The North Torrance Saxons and Peninsula Panthers look to improve their playoff chances, while the Da Vinci Wolves appear to have a high-scoring offense.

The non-league schedule should help prepare the Eagles for a run at a Pioneer League title. Coach Duffy says that's the goal and motivation, "To try and knock off South Torrance and improve our league record and win a first-round playoff game." He added, "Every day, everybody has an equal opportunity to get better, stronger, and faster."

Coach Duffy summed it up by saying, "We have a great staff, a very young and talented team, and are hoping for some big things over the next couple of years."

The Eagles host the Mira Costa Mustangs today at 3:30 p.m. •

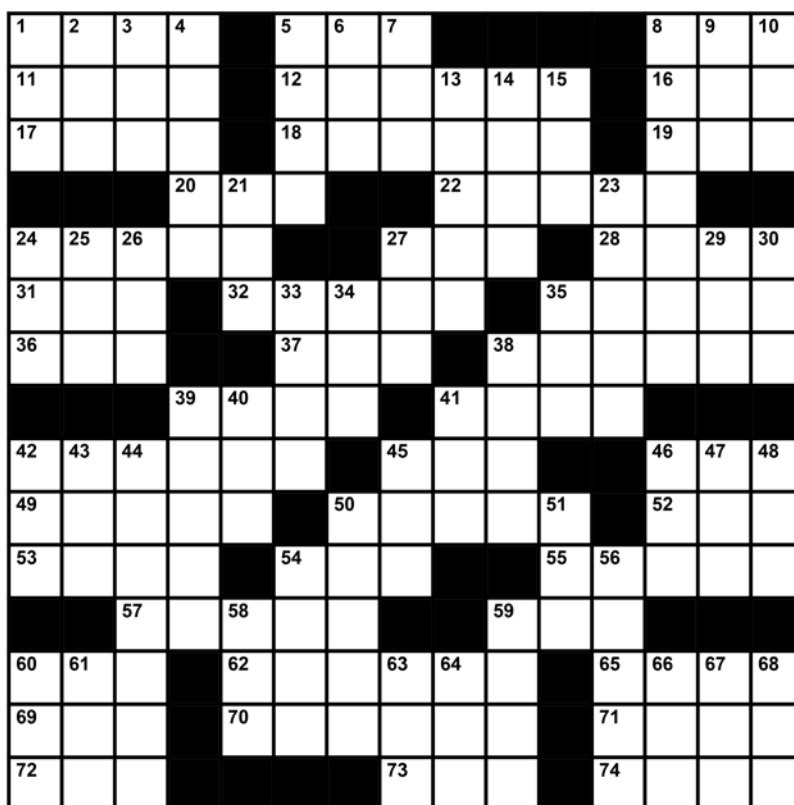

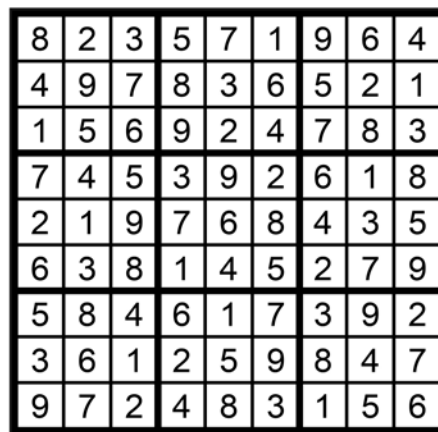

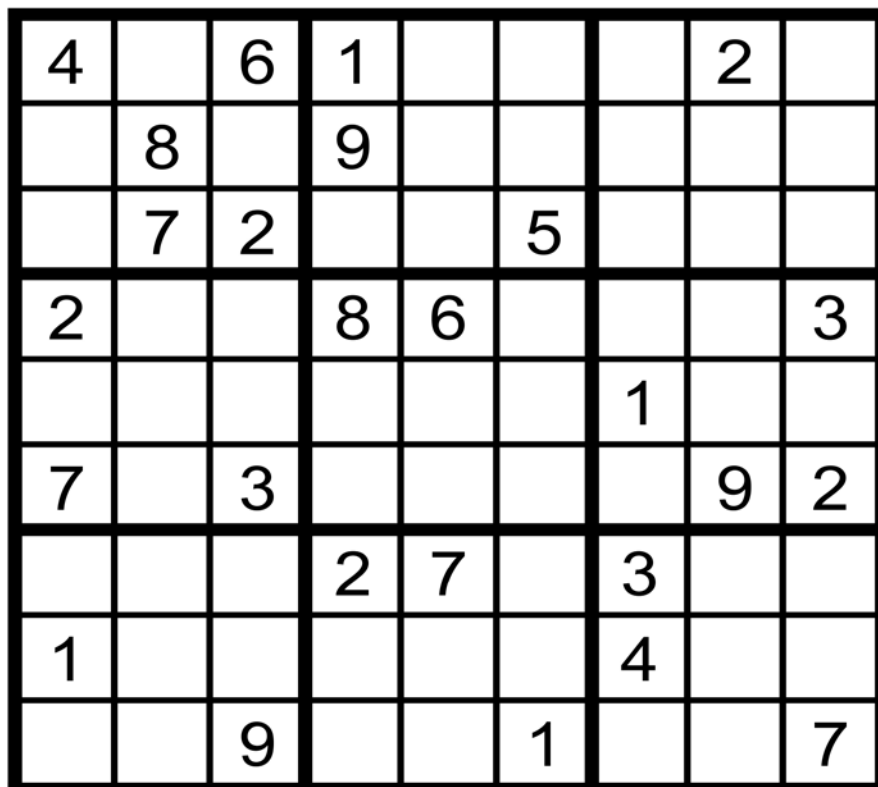

Film Review

Put Your Soul on Your Hand and Walk Review: Capturing Daily Life During Wartime Gaza

Among the buzzy titles in the Cannes Film Festival lineup this year, one independent film stood out from the rest. Documentarian Sepideh Farsi's *Put Your Soul on Your Hand and Walk* became front-page news when the main subject of her film, photojournalist Fatma Hassona, was tragically murdered just one day after receiving news that the film would screen at the festival. Fatma's shining spirit and irrefutable legacy will now live on posthumously in *Put Your Soul on Your Hand and Walk*. Now available to rent or buy on VOD with a DVD/Blu-ray release scheduled for January 2026.

Opening in Los Angeles this Friday, *Put Your Soul on Your Hand and Walk* offers a firsthand account of life under siege in Gaza, as experienced through the eyes of 25-year-old Palestinian photojournalist and poet Fatma Hassona. Captured through video calls, many of which suffer from poor quality, Fatma speaks candidly with director Sepideh Farsi as she recounts the horrible atrocities occurring daily on the streets of Gaza. Given the consistency and proximity of bombings, every interview and meeting with Fatma is a miracle. A talented photographer, Fatma shares some of the visceral and emotionally wrought photos she has captured over the months,

each one more devastating than the next.

On April 15, 2025, Sepideh unknowingly had her last conversation with Fatma. In a somewhat meta moment, Sepideh shares the news that the film will be playing at the Cannes Film Festival. Fatma's excitement is undeniable, and she enthusiastically tells Sepideh she plans to attend. At 1:00 am the following morning, Fatma and six members of her family were killed as they slept by a targeted Israeli airstrike on their home.

Put Your Soul on Your Hand and Walk is unlike any other documentary you'll see this year. The simplicity of the edit and overall production stands in stark contrast to the heaviness and importance of the subject matter. A seasoned independent documentary filmmaker, Sepideh Farsi breaks the fourth wall in her telling of Fatma's story. There are no bells and whistles, no fancy Hollywood magic; just a powerful story from a compelling narrator. By approaching the film in this way, Sepideh – knowingly or not – levels the playing field in terms of attainability and access. This film proves that anyone can make an impactful movie, regardless of budget.

Put Your Soul on Your Hand and Walk is the closest first-person POV possible to Gaza's frontlines. Through intimate and vulnerable conversation, Fatma heroically gives audiences a new perspective on the endless cycle of violence in her city. This is essential viewing, not only for its timely message, but also as a heartfelt tribute to a young woman who deserved to live her life to the fullest. •

Our Evenings by Alan Hollinghurst

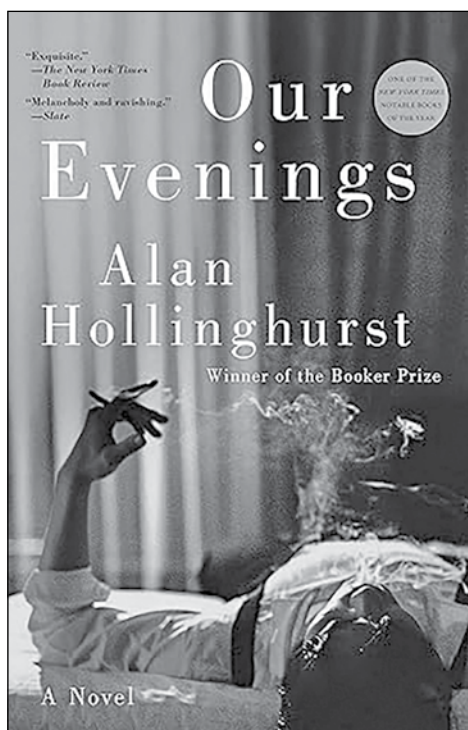

Alan Hollinghurst has received numerous awards for his exquisite writing throughout the years, including the Booker Prize. His most recent is the 2025 David Cohen prize for literature, one of the UK and Ireland's most prestigious honors for lifetime achievement in fiction. His latest novel *Our Evenings* was published in 2024 but was just lately added to the ESPL collection. I have been waiting to get my hands on this book, and I must say it was worth the wait. This intimate and atmospheric novel includes Hollinghurst's signature political, social and class issues seen through the lens of a multiracial child brought up by a sole parent, an outsider by race and class.

Set in Berkshire Downs in southern England from the 1960s through 2020, this personal narrative follows David Win, the child at the

center of the novel, born to an English mother and a Burmese father. His mother, Avril, is raising David alone and supports them as a seamstress and dressmaker. Exceptionally bright, David wins a scholarship to a prestigious boarding school. His benefactors, Mark and Cara Hadlow will be outsized influence on his life, as does their son Giles. However, Mark and Cara are positive and caring while Giles is anything but: a narcissistic boorish bully with little imagination.

Dave's relationships are the connective tissue of the novel. Dave's mother is the most important one, but his lovers and the Hadlows map the rest of the narrative. An outsider by reason of race and class, Dave is an astute observer of those around him, witnessing the privilege and prejudice of the upper class. *Our Evenings* is contemporary literary fiction that delves into gay liberation and race relations, guiding readers through the political and societal shifts in England during the novel's timeframe. With sensitivity and insight, Hollinghurst examines life, love, and the enduring importance of art through this stunning, intimate portrait of a man. •

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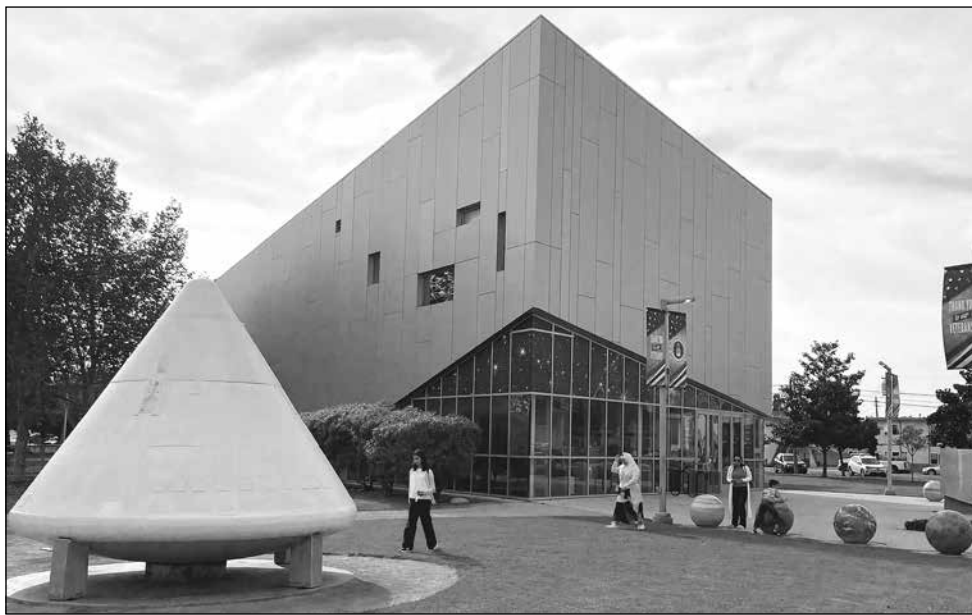

sight just up the freeway. A plaque and a portrait of the seven shuttle crew members, led by Mission Commander Husband, are found in a quiet area on the second floor. Husband was an Air Force test pilot who flew on a 10-day shuttle mission in 1999, which made history as the first spacecraft to dock with the International Space Station.

Three of the crew members had flown shuttle missions before, including payload commander Anderson and Chawla, who was an aerospace engineer tasked with operating the shuttle's robotic arm on a 1997 mission.

The gleaming, 20,000-square-foot museum doubles as a science center with an arcade feel to it. Kids huddle around the rocket-launch game near the front doors, watching as two players battle to see whose pump-action rocket can climb the highest. Just past the dueling rocketeers, a line forms along a wall of windows. Inside, children sit around small tables anxiously awaiting instructions on how to program a robot.

My nephew visited the space center often, on school field trips and with his mom and brother, and something clicked during one of those visits. He graduated from Purdue University with a degree in aeronautical engineering and now works on satellite launches in Huntsville, Alabama, home of NASA. The Columbia Space Center, which opened its doors in 2009, serves a dual purpose nowadays as a somber place to ponder the risks and achievements of the U.S. astronaut corps and a career incubator for kids and teens.

Between the permanent exhibits, classes, and special programs, children are introduced to science, technology, engineering, and math by the center's staff, referred to as guides. Granted, cracking a physics or calculus book isn't as much fun as picking up moon rocks with a mechanical claw or having a play date aboard a spaceship orbiting the Earth high.

Norwalk and museum officials in November made a big splash by announcing the center would be expanding and putting on display the full-scale mockup of the space shuttle orbiter that was given to the center more than a decade ago. Museum officials knew back then that more space would be needed someday. It's taken 13 years and an

\$800,000 restoration of the mock shuttle for that day to arrive.

The sleek, 122-foot-long model will be the centerpiece of the construction project. The city accepted the wooden mockup after Rockwell and Boeing closed the aerospace plant. When opened to the public in early 2027, the prototype built in 1972 will feature a stairwell entrance so visitors can step aboard rather than climb through a hatch, as the astronauts on America's 135 shuttle missions did to access the three levels.

Space Center leaders, city officials, community members, and Downey Unified School District students witnessed the groundbreaking for an expansion of the STEM-themed property on Nov. 17, with completion expected in a year. The center intends to expand and to add a science education complex through a mission it's calling "Project Inspiration," in keeping with the center's role as an incubator for kids and teens.

"It's going to be a hub of creativity, critical thinking, and dreaming big, as well as being a community resource for everyone in Southern California. We want to celebrate the past that got us here, but also really look to the future," said Ben Dickow, the president and executive director of the city-supported museum and center.

The nearly 40,000-square-foot expansion will draw students, families, educators, and the greater community to new spaces where they can connect and engage in fun, high-quality science learning programs, events, and experiences, Downey officials said at last month's ceremony.

On a busy day here, the girls and boys who are lucky enough to find a spot to sit in the NASA-style playhouse are having a blast while resting after their first-floor introduction to the interactive learning center, situated close to the 105 freeway on Imperial Avenue in Downey. The museum — just off the 105 freeway at Imperial Avenue — sits on a site of local significance. Supersonic flight and high-powered rocketry took shape there after World War II, and when the space and arms races between the U.S. and USSR reached a fevered pitch.

Like many aircraft manufacturers feeling the post-WWII economic slump, the Downey facility, known as North American Aviation from the early 1950s, turned its focus to supersonic aerodynamics and rocket propulsion, according to information posted on the space center's website. The Downey campus rapidly grew in the 1960s as the space race accelerated and President John F. Kennedy gave his "Choose to Go to the Moon" speech

in 1962, promising that the United States would put a man on the moon by the 1970s.

Museum chief executive Dickow said the ambitious \$50 million project is timed to afford visitors to Los Angeles for the 2028 Summer Olympic Games a chance to experience what it's like inside the shuttle model (minus the wings) and discover Downey's contribution to Apollo 11's successful lunar landing.

Astronaut Neil Armstrong called it a "giant leap for mankind, referencing the tens of thousands of men and women who worked behind the scenes to design, build, and operate the propulsion, steering, and space communications systems necessary for astronauts to reach the International Space Station orbiting 250 miles above the Earth. The vastness of space begins 62 miles, and the average distance to the moon is 238,855 miles, according to NASA. The trip can be longer or shorter, depending on Earth's tilt.

The center will host its annual lighting ceremony of the Apollo lunar module on the front lawn this Saturday from 4 to 7 p.m. This annual tradition features a tuba performance by a Cal State Fullerton ensemble, followed by the capsule lighting at 5:30.

I recently toured the Goodyear blimp and reported about a once-a-year opportunity to see it up close. That happens this Friday and Saturday when the airstrip next to the 405 freeway near Carson is open to the public. As part of the holiday Toys for Tots drive, the blimp crew asks that everyone visiting bring an unwrapped toy for a child this Christmas season and RSVP the number of guests planning to take a tour.

Drop off toys and stay for a ground tour from 4 to 7 p.m. Friday and 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Saturday. Use this link (https://www.goodyear.com/en_US/blimp/community-engagement/toys-for-tots.html) to RSVP.
