Capital Improvement Projects Recommended

Operating and capital outlay requests up to \$25,000 in the existing Citizens Option for Public Safety (COPS) Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Fund (SLESF) account by the Chief of Police. The grant requires that expenditures will be utilized to supplement "front line law enforcement" (includes hiring officers, funding special enforcement details, and purchasing equipment).
