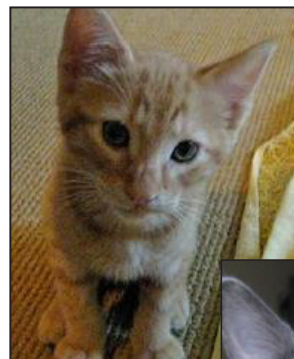
Mattie was one of our lucky girls who found the perfect forever home! Now that she's settled in, Mattie had her family send us a note about her wonderful new life together with them.....

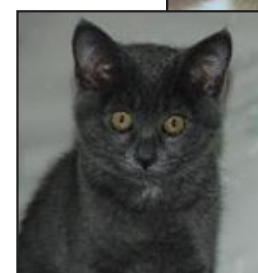
