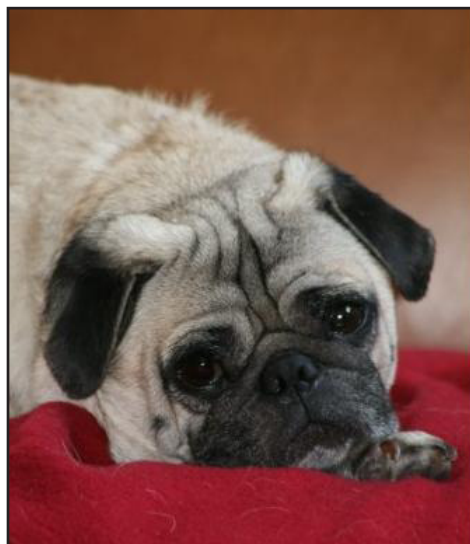

His rear right leg needed surgery for a fracture, but the procedure was botched by the original owners' veterinarian who was not certified to do orthopedic surgery. Cody was then taken to Dr. Craig at Veterinary Surgical Specialists to see if she could fix the original botched surgery. They were able to improve the pronation in his leg and make him pain-free, but he will always have a limp since he can't bend his knee. Because he now walked with a limp, his owner did not want him anymore, and Cody was surrendered to our rescue group in August 2008. It took us not but a week to adopt Cody into a home—he is a great dog! He fully recovered from his surgery, he is no longer in any pain and he gets around like any other dog. 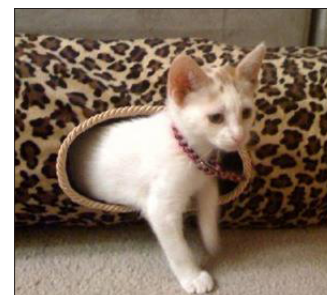
