Purrfect Companions



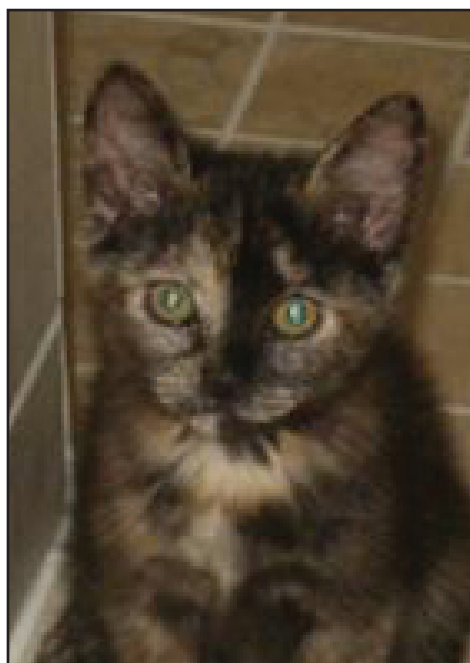
