He also enjoys playing throughout the day. He loves chasing the laser pointer and batting at dangling objects/strings. But overall, Pancake is a calm, sweet cat who is just a lover.

Snow is a gorgeous guy who has it all in the looks department: A lush, all-white coat and a handsome face with two different-colored eyes—one blue and the other yellow! He was a cherished house pet for 10 years, but he was orphaned when his 88-year-old animal-loving mom died, leaving him alone. A tad timid at first, Snow is an affectionate and friendly boy once he gets to know you. This good-natured kitty gets along with other cats, but is also quite content on his own. Snow has tested positive for feline leukemia (FeLV). Cats infected with FeLV may live for years (Snow certainly has!), and with proper care and nutrition they can enjoy a good quality of life. The disease is not contagious to people

or any animals other than cats. Snow is a wonderful, sweet kitty who sadly had the misfortune of being exposed to this disease. Yet, he is full of life and love and deserves a chance to live out the rest of his days in the comfort of a loving home. Snow would be a great companion to another FeLV+ cat. He could live in a home with cats vaccinated against FeLV, or could live in a home with no other cats. Won’t you open your heart and home to this deserving boy?

These kittens/cats are available for adoption through Kitten rescue, one of the largest cat rescue groups in Southern California. All of our kitties are spayed/neutered, microchipped, tested for FeLV and FIV, de-wormed and current on their vaccinations.
