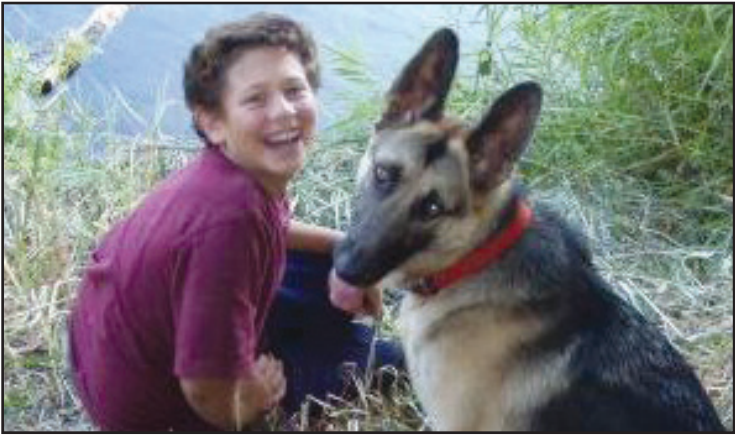

Here is a picture of Ruby and her buddy (our son) at our home away from home in Oregon. Thank you, Thank You again. With love, The Cruz Family”

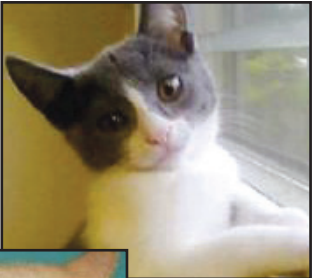

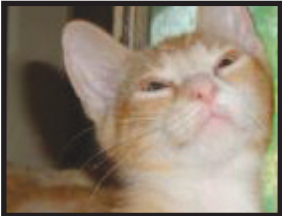
# Purrfect Companions
