## "WHILE YOU ARE OUT AND ABOUT"

The El Segundo Police Department reminds everyone that by taking a few simple precautions, you can reduce the risk to yourself, and also discourage those who commit crimes of opportunity.

The following tips can help you avoid becoming a victim of a crime when you are out and about around town.

- Try to *never* walk or jog alone at night. Invite a friend along for company.
- Stay in well-lighted areas, away from alleys, bushes, and entryways.
- Walk confidently, directly, and at a steady pace.
- Walk on the side of the street facing oncoming traffic.

- Never take a short cut through an alley, vacant lot, parking lot or construction site.
  - Never engage in conversation with a stranger.
  - If a driver stops to ask directions, avoid getting near the vehicle.
  - If a car appears to be following you, turn and walk in the opposite direction.
  - If you are in trouble, attract help *any way* you can.
  - Be aware of your surroundings and the people around you.
  - Above all, have a cell phone accessible with the police dispatch phone number pre-programmed: 310-524-2760 or 911 in an emergency.

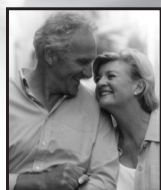
