One male adult was arrested at 1743 hours from the 300 block of North Sepulveda Boulevard for petty theft with a prior and a parole violation warrant.

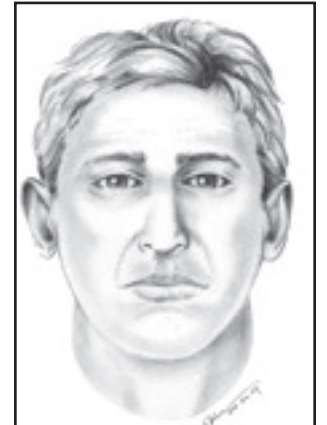
## THURSDAY, AUGUST 27

# Indecent Exposure Suspect Strikes Again

On Friday, August 21, 2009 at approximately 6 p.m., a male exposed himself to two female adolescents near Lomita Street at Pine Avenue in the City of El Segundo. The juveniles were walking westbound on Pine Avenue at Lomita Street when they saw a car parked in the alley between Lomita Street and Sierra Street. The suspect was standing to the rear of the vehicle with his shorts pulled down, exposing himself and committing lewd acts.

The suspect is described as a male white in his mid to late 20s, 5'10" to 6'0" tall, medium build with short blonde hair, wearing a gray t-shirt and blue basketball style shorts. The car was described as a newer model four-door compact, grey or light blue in color.

The man matches the description of a suspect involved with six other similar incidents in El Segundo that have occurred over the past ten months:

November 6, 2008 at 7:45 a.m., in the alley north of the 800 block of Grand Avenue.

January 8, 2009 at 7:35 a.m., in the alley east of the 400 block of Standard Street.

March 13, 2009 at 2:45 p.m., in the 300

block of West Mariposa Avenue.

April 4, 2009 at 7:00 p.m., in the 300 block of West Pine Avenue.

June 29, 2009 at 7:55 p.m., in the 700 block of California Street.

August 1, 2009 at 3:12 p.m., in the alley east of the 400 block of Standard Street.

August 21, 2009 at 6:00 p.m., in the alley west of the 400 block of Lomita Street.

During each incident, the suspect was wearing a long or short sleeved t-shirt, athletic "basketball" type shorts and targeted adolescent females. On two occasions he was wearing a blue/white/green striped baseball type hat.

The victims have described various vehicles including a newer model, dark blue four door car; an older white compact car; a white full-sized four door car; and a newer model grey or light blue, four door compact.
