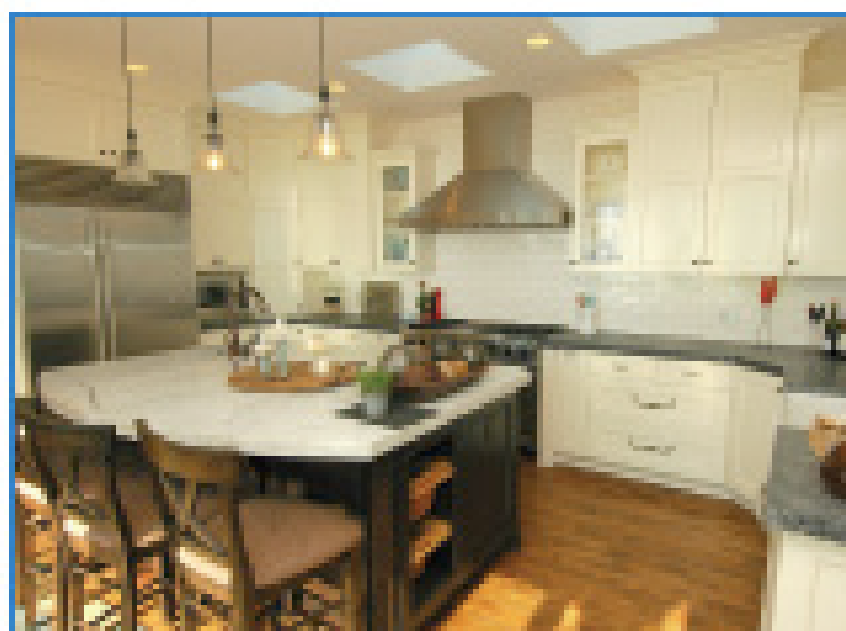




Ocean Drive at Second



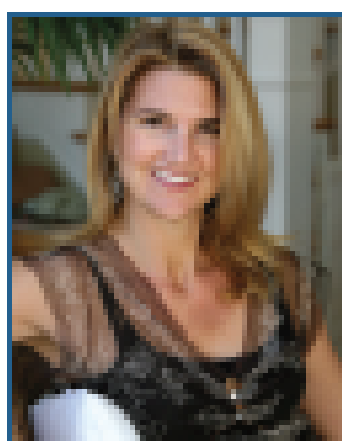
