Final Week Dedicated to Approval of Proposition 55

With less than a week until the election, there is a final push by all candidates and propositions to obtain voter approval. Among those efforts is the push for voters to say yes to Proposition 55.

Proposition 55, the California Children's Education and Health Care Protection Act, adds a 12-year extension to the current income tax rates on single Californians earning more than \$250,000 and couples earning more than \$500,000 a year.

"Every time we go out to speak one-on-one with the community, they have been very receptive," 5th Grade Teacher at Kornblum Elementary School George Amaya said. "It is not that we are asking for extra anything, we are just asking to keep things solvent so we can be productive in the classroom."

If approved Proposition 55 will prevent billions of dollars in budget cuts without the need to raise taxes; the initiative is expected to generate an average of \$8 billion per year, which would be used to continue funding education. In 2012 California voters approved Proposition 30, which raised the sales tax from 7.25 to 7.5 percent in an effort to fund education. That proposition also created four high-income tax brackets for people earning more than \$250,000, \$300,000, \$500,000 and \$1,000,000, which Proposition 55 would extend for more than a decade.

"Unfortunately Proposition 30 sunsets and some of the funding that we received goes away wit it; if it goes away here in Hawthorne we could lose \$10 million," Amaya said. "Proposition 55 is basically a continuation of Proposition 30 but the sales tax element goes away; the only tax that remains is that tax on wealthier Californians."

However, opponents to proposition 55 point out that the tax singles out people in certain

income brackets, forcing them to continue carrying a fiscal burden that was supposed to be temporary under Proposition 30. In addition, it is argued that since the state has reduced it debt and gone from a \$16 billion deficit in 2012 to a \$2.7 billion surplus this year, there is no need for the tax to continue. Still, supporters see more value in having those tax-generated funds available for education than in eliminating the tax.

"Every position that we have here is a crucial and an integral part of the education machine," Amaya said. "If we are missing a dean, coaches or teachers in the classroom, it changes the dynamic and makes things more difficult because children come to school no matter what."

In 2009 and 2010, the Hawthorne School District was at risk of losing more than 150 teachers, which makes up a quarter of the district's teaching force. The school district and its employees, which have a strong working relationship, were able to navigate the difficult financial times and are hoping to avoid losing funds again.

"Before we had Prop 30 we had furlough days, causing students to miss out on too much of the school year; we were doing layoffs every single year, class sizes were getting bigger, and we didn't have much of the support that we have now and that allows us to provide to our schools and our students," Hawthorne School District Superintendent Dr. Helen Morgan said. "Now we are able to have deans at every school, counselors, intervention teachers, content coaches and a staff that provides all the extra support for teachers and students to better perform."

In addition, if certain budgetary requirements are met, the initiative will provide up to \$2 billion annually to improve healthcare access to lowincome families. The focus is on preventative care and aims to keep kids healthy in order to save the state money in the long run. The funds generated if the proposition passes will be used to prevent any cuts to the state's community colleges, which in turn will avoid raises in tuition while helping to provide more classes. The state estimates that an additional 22,000 teachers will be needed by next year, making approval of Prop 55 crucial for school districts to be able to afford to hire new teachers.

"One of the unanticipated side effects of the roller coaster that is education funding is the lack of job security, especially for a brand new teacher out of school," Dr. Morgan said. "It is not a tremendously well-paying job for a college degree level position so we end up with teacher shortages. We had a loss of teachers, but when we got all of this funding back we were able to add back positions; but now we are at a point where we have a teacher shortage again."

While Proposition 55 has received broad support from diverse groups, teachers supporting the ballot measure have one thing in mind.

"This is not a nine to five job; we do work long hours, we do take work home and work way passed the hours that we are supposed to and it is because we love our job," Amaya said. "You have to have a passion for it; you didn't become a teacher for the money because we aren't going to get rich from this; we do this because we have a passion for it and want to help others.

"We help shape these children for the future and at least I don't take that for granted," Amaya concluded. •

El Segundo Offense Too Much for Hawthorne

Hawthorne pulled off an incredible upset win over El Segundo last season, however, the Eagles' defense forced four turnovers in a 35-7 dominating win last Friday at Halcap field. The Cougars fall to 3-6 on the season and 2-2 in Ocean League play.

El Segundo (8-1, 3-1) is locked in a

three-way tie for first place with Lawndale and Culver City. The Ocean League will be decided Friday when all teams play in the season finale.

El Segundo took an early 7-0 lead in the first quarter when quarterback Kobee Lagarde hit Billy Brasher for a 21-yard touchdown. The Cougars responded with quarterback Marte Mapu's 15-yard touchdown pass to wide receiver Carlos Jacobo, tying the game, 7-7, with 9:00 left in the second quarter.

The Eagles come right back with a 67-yard drive, capped by a 10-yard touchdown pass from Lagarde to Ashton Saltz. After back-to-back interceptions by Mapu, El Segundo capitalized on the turnovers with 26-yard touchdown run by running back Taz Tauaese, extending the lead, 21-7, with two minutes left in the second quarter.

On the ensuing drive, Mapu is intercepted by the Eagles' Taj Balogun, which set up Palmer's 25-yard touchdown pass to Brasher, with just under a minute left in the first half. El Segundo took a 28-7 lead into halftime.

On defense, the Eagles were able to shut out Hawthorne in the second half with tough defensive line play. Mapu was intercepted four times and sacked twice. Brasher hauled in an 8-yard touchdown pass from Jake Palmer for his third touchdown of the night and putting the game out of reach in the fourth quarter.

Taurese finished with 102 yards on 15 carries while Brasher added five receptions for 101 yards. Jacobo finished with four receptions for 42 yards and a touchdown for the Cougars.

Hawthorne will play its final game of the season Friday when they travel to Lawndale Friday for a 7 p.m. kickoff.

LAWNDALE VS. BEVERLY HILLS

Lawndale remains in a three-way tie for first place in the Ocean League with a 67-0 rout of Beverly Hills last Friday. The Cardinals (4-4, 2-1) will host Hawthorne Friday at 7 p.m. in the season finale.

LEUZINGER VS. WEST TORRANCE

Leuzinger was led by its ground game as they rushed for 432 yards to help the Olympians defeat Torrance, 25-10, last Friday. Leuzinger remains undefeated in the Pioneer League as they head towards the season finale against Centennial Friday at 7 p.m.

Leuzinger running back Daniel Carmicle rushed for 194 yards while adding touchdown runs of 88 and 65 yards. The Olympians (7-2, 4-0) led 18-10 at halftime and added a touchdown in the fourth quarter to seal the win.


INGLEWOOD VS. REDONDO UNION



- 2 cups rinsed and sorted fresh cranberries
- 1/4 cup raisins
- 3/4 cup orange juice
- 2 teaspoons melted butter

Preparation

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Cut 1/2-inch top off the stem end of the apples. Remove the stems, leaving a small hole into which you can insert a cinnamon stick. Core the apples with a melon baller. Discard cores. Scoop out the inside of the apples, being careful not to pierce the skin. Chop the flesh. Set aside.
- 2. Combine the cranberries, raisins, chopped apple flesh, orange juice, butter, nutmeg, vanilla, and orange peel in a medium bowl. Stuff this mixture inside the hollowed-out apples and place in lightly greased oven-proof dish.
- 3. Replace cap on each apple, with a cinnamon stick through the stem opening. Spread any extra stuffing around the apples and bake in preheated oven until tender, about 45 minutes.
