City's PATCHES Program Making Inroads in Addressing Homelessness

Homelessness continues to be a significant nationwide issue and is especially rampant in Los Angeles County, where last year's estimated count exceeded 75,000 individuals. Unfortunately, El Segundo is not immune to the problem, with 8-10 percent of all police calls connected to citizen reports and complaints about homeless activity on local streets. While it's difficult to predict when a transient person might arrive in town and the length of stay, the City of El Segundo has found recent success in getting homeless people into housing or treatment. It's all thanks to the PATCHES program that promotes an allhands-on-deck, collaborative process to help those experiencing homelessness receive the resources needed to improve their lot in life. PATCHES (Proactive Approach To Combatting Homelessness) incorporates all City departments in addressing the problem. "Homelessness isn't really a police matter-it's a community matter where we all need to work together," said ESPD Lieutenant Luke Muir, who oversees the effort from the police side. "We get together once a month, we collaborate and identify issues we are all seeing. We put our heads together and come up with solutions that are going to be long-lasting. The goal is long-term help and not quick fixes. It's about getting people into housing, getting them off the street, and actually fixing the problem. And the program is making some progress."

Said progress is quantifiable. The PATCHES effort since last July prompted 19 homeless individuals in El Segundo to accept resources. Of those, 15 remain in housing, and only four returned to the streets—an outcome Muir deemed a huge success. "A couple got into VA, and two others reunited with families out of state," he reported as examples. In another case, a mother and daughter had nowhere to go after being evicted from a

hotel. "The woman—a domestic violence victim—had family in Mexico and wished to return. We worked with the South Bay Council of Governments [South Bay COG] to keep her in the hotel another night, and then we transported her to the Mexican consulate in Los Angeles so that she could effectively reunite with her family." Muir added that it's vital to do things the "right way" when helping

She was right! It gave me a headache. I was told last week that other streets had papers in the middle of them, surrounded by leaves. The wind is the culprit in moving papers to




El Segundo's Version of Pirates of the Caribbean

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

Eagles Are Having a Great Spring

It has been a wonderful start to the spring sports season for the El Segundo Eagles. The golf team has begun its schedule 11-0 and 4-0 in the Ocean League. The baseball team has started 9-2, while the softball team has opened up 12-3. The volleyball team has soared to a 13-2 record. Between the baseball, softball, and golf teams, they each won a tournament, which was the first time that each had won a tournament in the same year.

Golf Team Preparing for Tournaments

The Eagles were 18-2 a year ago on their way to a CIF title. They have backed that up this season by starting 11-0 including four wins in the Ocean League. Head coach David March says the start has been great, but with the tournament season coming, the focus has been on consistent team scoring and added emphasis on practice and match preparation. "The group knows we are playing better individually, but collectively, as a group, we still have to find improvement. We haven't had a round where all five players go low together."

Coach March gives credit to the group for reducing their individual bad rounds. "Our focus is to keep going lower as a team week over week. The weather has been a really big factor in scoring with rain, wind, and cold." According to Coach March, the team's offseason preparation has helped not make the weather the major factor it has been to the opposing teams. "Our mental toughness and team strength are starting to help separate us in these tough weather matches."

In recent matches, the Eagles have defeated some high-profile schools, including Chadwick 169-196 at Westchester GC. Shaan Ty Patel 32(E) and Lukas Da Silva 33(+1) led the Eagles during a challenging day, weatherwise, with wind and cold conditions.

Against Torrance at Los Verdes GC the Eagles were in command from the start during the rainy conditions during most of the match and won 192-223. It was the Ocean League opener, and Lukas Da Silva 36(E), Jack Harris 37(+1), and Shaan Ty Patel 37(+1) demonstrated why the Eagles are looking to repeat as league champions. The Eagles dominated Torrance again 167-193 at Westchester GC in a league match to improve to 2-0. Lukas Da Silva and Shaan Ty Patel 32(E) led the route over a good Tartars team.

The Eagles swept the Culver City Centaurs 185-227 at Alondra GC and 162-193 at

Westchester GC. In the first match, Jack Harris 34(-2) and Andre Sugden 37(+1) led the team to a wide margin of victory, while Shaan Ty Patel 29(-3) and Lukas Da Silva 31(-1) were outstanding in the second match.

It was a big win to improve to 4-0 in the Ocean League and kept the momentum going and showed steady team improvement over the last few weeks according to Coach March.

This week, the Eagles played host to Chaminade HS, the number two team in the rugged Mission League, in an 18-hole match. Coach March said, "These are the matches you schedule to prepare for playoffs. We beat them last season at Balboa GC, so they will be focused and motivated to win."

The Eagles have been undefeated at home (Westchester GC) for the past two years, and they are very aware of this, so there is motivation for the Eagles to continue their streak. League matches against West Torrance on the road Tuesday at Alondra GC and home Thursday at Westchester GC highlight the other matches.

Baseball Team Hits a Snag in Schedule

The Eagles' strong start to the season hit a snag when they dropped two in a row after a lopsided win. The Eagles took care of the Redondo Sea Hawks 11-3 in a game where all nine starters had at least one hit apiece. Ethan Ayler and Chase Mattoon led the 16hit attack. Ayler had a two-run double in the first inning, while Mattoon hit his third home run of the season. Porter Robbins tossed five strong innings before Tyler Cohen shut the door on the Sea Hawks.

The Eagles lost for the first time this season when they fell to the Peninsula Panthers 2-0. Jake Collins pitched well enough to win by giving up just two hits. But both hits came timely when the Panther's Aaron Monzon doubled in Brenden Jarrod in the fourth inning to make it 1-0. Monzon's solo home run in the sixth inning made it 2-0. The Eagles could not take advantage of seven walks, a hit-by-pitch, and five hits. In the end, they stranded twelve base runners.

Then facing the La Habra Highlanders on the road in a non-league game, proved to be a lackluster offense and lost 3-1. They had eight hits but couldn't string them together to produce anything but one run in the fifth inning. Ben Lee's groundball scored Anders Tipton from third base for the only run for the Eagles. Sam Forthuber started his first game of the year and looked sharp pitching into the fifth inning.

The Eagles have a key home and home series this week against South Torrance. They were on the road yesterday and will host the Spartans on Friday at 3:30 p.m. On Saturday, the Eagles will host the perennial powerhouse Royal Highlanders at 10 a.m.

Softball Eagles Continue Impressive Start

The Eagles played a rigorous schedule last week. They played six games and won all six, including wins over powerhouses Redondo 1-0, West Torrance 3-2, and Los Altos 5-2 to win their first Torrance National Tournament. Then, for good measure and to fill out the week, they defeated Trinity League power Mater Dei on the road 5-2 and ended the week with a convincing 7-4 win over the Crescenta Valley Falcons.

The pitching of senior Jacy Lindsay in those six games was nothing short of dominant. Not only did she win all six decisions to improve to 10-2 on the season, but she lowered her ERA to 2.13. The offense has been strong, too, with timely hitting from Sienna Mayer, who has hit safely in 14 out of 15 games this season and is hitting .585. Three sophomores have shown pop in their bat, including Marilyn McCaverty, who is hitting .419 with four home runs; Carter Cswaykus, who is hitting .378 with four home runs and Sullivan McLaughlin, who is second on the team with 16 RBIs along with four home runs.

The Eagles have a key Pioneer League matchup on Friday when they host West

Torrance at 3:30 p.m. Volleyball Team Getting a Rude Welcome to Bay League


The Eagles' run to a CIF title and Regional title in 2023 meant that when re-leaguing this year, the Eagles were placed into arguably one of the top leagues in Southern California. In their match against Peninsula, the Eagles were swept in three games. They faced Mira Costa on Tuesday and host South Torrance today at 3:30 p.m. and Mira Costa on Friday at 3:30 p.m.

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

The Assessment Review: Parenthood is Turned Into a Darkly Dystopian Game

What immediately piqued my interest in The Assessment wasn't the headlining cast or the Pinterest-worthy production design photos. No, it was the film's director, the French visual artist Fleur Fortuné. Having personally worked in the commercial and music video industry for over a decade, I'd recognize Fortuné's visual style anywhere. She expertly blends surreal and whimsical imagery with compelling narratives, which makes for unforgettable cinematic feats. Fortuné uses her artistic strengths in The Assessment, a dystopian story about a couple's struggle to have a child for reasons other than you'd expect.

Starring Alicia Vikander, Elizabeth Olsen, and Himesh Patel, The Assessment is a psychologically provocative minefield. Set in the near future where parenthood is strictly controlled, Mia (Olsen) and Aaryan (Patel) are ready to take their relationship to the next level. They want to have a baby. However, the reality of this dream coming true is far more laborious than it once was. In this dystopian landscape, resources are limited and the government has total control over reproduction rights. Despite being a successful couple in every sense of the word, Mia and Aaryan have to undergo a seven-day assessment to determine if they are "fit" enough to have a child.

It doesn't take long before their assessor, Virginia (Vikander), arrives at the couple's home. Without delay, she quickly begins the

highly confidential and borderline inhumane process. At first glance, Virginia seems like a levelheaded, unbiased judge of character. Any nerves the couple have are momentarily put at ease. However, Virginia's test quickly unravels into their worst psychological nightmare. Virginia begins acting like a child, roleplaying every worst-case scenario regardless of harmful intent. Mia and Aaryan's relationship begins to crack as they-for the first time-question the very foundations of their society and whether their relationship can survive.

Elizabeth Olsen and Himesh Patel do an excellent job grounding the film in reality while simultaneously pushing against Alicia Vikander's absurdity. Vikander has a lot to play with as Virginia, her performance reminds me of her role in the Mike Mills short film I Am Easy to Find. Vikander is theatrical, brash, and at times borders on annoying. However, her role is to push Mia and Aaryan's patience threshold. And in doing this, she successfully tests the audience's patience as well.

The retro-futuristic world of The Assessment is beautiful, almost museum-like. Stunning production design by Jan Houllevigue and art design by Philippe Mayanobe bring to life a cohesive blend of fantasy and reality. Further driving the mood is the original score by Emilie Levienaise-Farrouch whose previous work includes All of Us Strangers and Censor.


Filmmaker Fleur Fortuné crafts a darkly humorous and poignant thesis statement in The Assessment. At its core, it requires us to get introspective and consider what we're willing to sacrifice for our heart's desire. It's a chilling film to watch, and one that's not easy to forget. •

a homeless person leave the area for a specific destination. "If an individual requests to go to, say, San Bernardino, we're not going to just give them a bus ticket. We'll call to confirm there are family members willing to accept and house this individual. We work with the County or South Bay COG to pay for bus or plane tickets."

While studies suggest economic factors are the chief cause of homelessness, Muir pointed out that there is usually more to it. "We see addiction-related issues and mental health challenges-particularly in the ones who are service-resistant," he said and went on to laud the work of the Department of Mental Health for its role in making actual progress. "They are paramount in getting individuals help."

Also critical in the program are the San Pedro-based Harbor Interfaith Services, which provides housing and shelter for the homeless;-and Los Angeles Homeless Services (LAHSA)-a joint powers authority that manages funding for homeless services and housing. Outreach workers from these organizations come to town to assess individuals on the street. "It's beneficial to have a clinician as a teammate," Muir noted. "They might come out and do an evaluation and find someone having a crisis that meets the criteria of having to be hospitalized for a 72-hour psychiatric evaluation and be placed in a home. We've seen that often. It's an opportunity to get this person long-term help."

Muir and El Segundo Deputy City Manager Barbara Voss recently addressed the District Attorney's Task Force on Homelessness at the Hall of Justice in Downtown Los Angeles about PATCHES. She attributed a key element of the program's success to a stronger attention to data. "We developed a system where we can track all our outreach to every individual our officers come in contact with, and we can identify if we have contacted the same individual before and what resources were provided as well as what their response was to the resources," she said. "This gives us a better idea of what's working and what's not working and how we can improve services to the individuals."

Residents are also a major component of the collaborative effort with the El Segundo Connect platform (launched last summer), which is one way to report persons experiencing homelessness. As of press time, ES Connect posted 39 complaints related to homeless activity. "This allows an officer to be assigned to go out and investigate, talk to the individual, and provide resources," Voss explained. "From there, the officers fill out an investigation form that will go into a database, and the referrals can be sent automatically to service providers. Lt. Muir can look at the history of the individual and see where this person has been over the last six months if they met with Harbor Interfaith or declined services. It gives us more information to provide a more well-rounded solution."


Even so, Muir warned that most of the individuals are transitory. They come into the city for a brief period-sometimes just for a day or two-and then go. Then there are those with a connection to El Segundo. "We have a number of individuals who are home-grown," he said. "They grew up here or spent some time in the community and that broughtthem back here after living somewhere else. At least two or three meet that criteria."

El Segundo homeless people tend to gravitate toward predictable locations, such as the vacant 20-acre area between The Point shopping plaza and the train tracks running east from Chevron and along the train tracks going toward Rosecrans and Aviation. "There is almost always an encampment at the beach," Muir said, adding that Public Works staff does an "incredible job" cleaning up and sanitizing those areas once the transients leave.

Muir noted that those willing to accept resources usually come from somewhere else and are new to the city. "There is a

percentage of the population we consider service-resistant," he said. "We offer resources, programs, that there are beds available... but for one reason or another, they are reluctant to take advantage of those programs, and they say no repeatedly. We contact them over and over and over again, and they say no over and over again. Those are the ones with prior ties to El Segundo."

Before PATCHES, all homeless-related calls went to the police department. Back in 2007, the homeless count in town was only two. However, the number began to increase between 2010-15 and continued to swell until reaching 31 last October-an amount Muir admitted is high for a community of only 5.5 square miles. The PATCHES engagement team, consisting of five officers and one sergeant, goes out quarterly to conduct head counts and offer resources simultaneously. The numbers tend to increase in warmer weather months while decreasing during colder periods. "Over time, we can see if our program is working and track the progress through our database," Muir said.

Before his promotion to lieutenant in 2022, Muir was a sergeant for two years in charge of the Community Engagement division that ran the homeless outreach team. "In the past, officers would get a call and come out and offer resources," he said. "If the person said no, then the officer would leave them alone. But now, we have some legal authority to detain that person and to dig a little deeper."

That legal authority stems from a 2024 Supreme Court ruling in the Grant's Pass vs. Johnson decision that allowed cities to enact legislation outlawing camping. The move enabled the El Segundo City Attorney to draft an anti-camping ordinance that the Council adopted last October. "Now our police department has some teeth,' Muir explained. "It made it a misdemeanor to set up an encampment. Encampment is considered just laying on the sidewalk with a bed roll, blanket, or sleeping bag. So this gives our officers some leverage. Enforcement is going to be the last effort, if necessary. We're going to contact individuals, try to get them resources, identify them, put them in our database, and see what's working."

Voss added that the City Council identified homelessness as part of its strategic plan. The City Manager's office facilitates the interdepartmental group that comprises the PATCHES team. "It's not just a priority for PD, but for Public Works; Recreation, Parks and Library; and the City Manager's office, so we're all working together to assist the police with resources and educate the public," she said. "The team approach is new."

While the County has its own program, El Segundo studied other cities that made notable headway in dealing with homelessness. PATCHES' progress in a relatively short period led to the aforementioned initiation to the Hall of Justice to share success stories and program particulars. "It was an honor that El Segundo was asked to talk about best practices and some of the things we are doing," Voss said. "The results speak for themselves." Voss also emphasized that local citizens who see a homeless person often think, "What can I do to help?" They might, in those cases, offer some money or clothing. "The best thing to do is to contact the City through El Segundo Connect. ESPD will go out and engage the PATCHES team to provide resources."

As for future goals for PATCHES, Muir sees the most realistic path as continuing to help get people off the streets and into housing. "We've always looked through the lens of compassion," he said. "These are people... and we want to ensure we are getting them help-even those who are resistant. Our view is to not give up, keep pushing forward, educate the community, and get them involved. To keep using El Segundo Connect, communicate with businesses and contact us to ensure we are all being as proactive as possible. Every individual we are able to get off the street, to me, that's a major success..." •

"One, but it's here in the living room, kind of in the center of the house."

"You have cable?"

"Well yeah, some of the channels, sure..." Our son can sleep on the futon in the office?" "Well, yeah, just have to move it in there."

- 10 ounces carrot, peeled and spiralized using blade with medium holes (about 3 cups)
- 1 cup Swanson[®] Vegetable Broth

Directions

- Step 1: Stir the garlic, ginger, vinegar, soy sauce and honey in a small bowl. Set aside 3 tablespoons soy sauce mixture in a separate bowl (for coating the fish). Reserve the remaining soy sauce mixture. Brush the fish with the 3 tablespoons soy sauce mixture and discard any left over.
- Step 2: Heat 1 tablespoon sesame oil in a 12-inch nonstick skillet over medium heat. Add the fish and cook for 6 minutes or until lightly browned on both sides and cooked through. Remove the fish from the skillet, cover and keep warm in the oven at 200°F.
- Step 3: Wipe the skillet clean. Add the remaining sesame oil and heat over medium heat. Add the vegetable noodles and cook for 3 minutes. Add the reserved soy sauce mixture and broth and cook for 3 minutes or until the vegetable noodles are tender. Season to taste. Serve the salmon over the vegetable noodles.


