Little League 11-Year-Old All-Stars Win District 36 Tournament

The El Segundo Little League All-Star teams have garnered some 39 championship Little League banners, including ones for winning District 36, Section 4, and one Southern California State Championship. You can add a fortieth banner to an already crowded and impressive history of El Segundo Little League. The 11-year-old All-Stars went through their District 36 tournament undefeated and capped their championship with a convincing 6-2 win over Palos Verdes Little League.

This year's team is essentially the same one that captured the Southern California State championship last season as 10-year-olds. This team rolled through the District 36 tournament with relative ease, and when they defeated Palos Verdes Little League in the winner's bracket final, it meant a trip to the championship final.



Brody Brooks was 3-for-3 in the championship game, including hitting this second-inning solo home run.

In the District 36 championship game, El Segundo faced Palos Verdes Little League for the second time. PVLL advanced to the elimination championship game after defeating Hermosa Beach Little League. El Segundo used great pitching and timely hitting to win 6-2.

El Segundo sent Jaxon Kalish to the mound to quiet a solid Palos Verdes lineup. The hardthrowing right-hander was unhittable through his four innings, striking out six and walking two. The closest PVLL came to getting a hit off Kalish was in the third inning when Robert Slane hit a ground ball between Colby Lee and Declan McRoberts into right field. Right fielder Lennon Salazar charged and fielded the ball and threw it to McRoberts at first base for the final out of the inning.

El Segundo took a 3-0 lead in the first inning. See Sports, page 8

practices while also plying his tonsorial trade at one of the offices. Heather, who calls herself "a stay-at-home Mom," is tasked with the billing processes for the offices.

Heather and Steve moved back to El Segundo in 2015 after a stint living in Manhattan Beach and bought the house in which she was raised. The Sutherlands asked her stepson Cooper if he wanted to continue attending Mira High School. Cooper said he "wanted to play baseball on the same field that his dad did," so the Sutherlands started the process of relocating to El Segundo. "We bought the house from my dad, and that started our El Segundo adventure," she said.

Part of Heather's adventure is serving the town in a volunteer capacity, toiling for the past two years as the Center Street School (CSS) PTA president. In the 2022-23 school year, she will double-dip PTA duties; she will still work on the CSS board and assume a position on the High School PTA board.

Sutherland is also the co-chair of the annual Ed! Foundation soiree, Ladies Night Out, and serves on their board. She started as a runway model, then was asked to serve on the Ladies Night Out committee, and is now co-chair. Asked if she could divulge any scandalous stories from prior shindigs, she demurred, saying, "it is always a good time...and that last time, I was completely 100 % sober, because I was the chair. I think that I will never drink at a Ladies Night Out again, because it was so entertaining."

Sutherland said her hair-cutting days are behind her. During the advent of COVID, she tried to focus on "things that bring me passion and happiness." These include traveling, [she has an August Hawaii trip planned], running on the Strand, and steadfastly walking the streets of El Segundo.

Here is what some of her confidants say about Sutherland. Melissa McCaverty has known Sutherland for eight years. "I first met Heather just through living in El Segundo, PTA, the Ed! Foundation," McCaverty emailed. "Our friendship grew even closer through our love of early morning exercise and having kids with the same interests.

"She really does embrace the small-town lifestyle we have here. She is the most generous person I have ever known - not only would she do anything for anyone, but she is also generous with her time," continued McCaverty. "Her volunteer activities are a full-time job. She would do anything for anybody lucky enough to call her a friend and even for those people that she does not even know. She truly is one of a kind. She supports her friends and neighbors in any way she can, unlike anyone I have ever met. She is real, honest, and vulnerable - which are qualities I admire. This is what makes you feel like you have been friends with her forever."


Most people see Heather tackling the streets of El Segundo, but they do not know that during those miles that her Garmin is tracking, she is also logging minutes on her Air Pods, likely on a call handling CSS PTA business, Ed! Foundation tasks or talking to a school board member.

"She is an individual that holds down a family of three boys," said Huie, "who are still going through all the school things, plus sports and extracurriculars, on top of assisting her husband with the business/financial side of his private practice. With all that, she will drop it all to figure out how to support her sister who just had a baby, her mom, who recently recovered from knee/hip surgeries, her fatherin-law's doctor appointments, watching a friend's kid in a pinch, and the list goes on and on. She is selfless to the core and gives back to this community and its people whenever, wherever, and however she can!"

Emailed Cheryl Smith: "I have known Heather for eight years. I have been Heather's "co-worker" - as we are both professional volunteers. I have been her friend. I have been her workout buddy. "She is fabulous! She has one of the most giving, generous, and caring hearts. She is always there to support people. She tells it like it is. She is honest and genuine. She is conscientious, reliable, and hard-working. When she says she will do something, she does it. Nothing stops her.

"We have worked on so many committees together," Smith said. "She is always looking for the smarter way to do things and to do what makes sense. El Segundo is so lucky to have such a caring community member. We are a better town because of her efforts."





they inadvertently found themselves caught in the middle of an unexpected volcanic eruption. Although their love story ended too soon and their contribution to the scientific community feels incomplete, what they did leave behind is hundreds of hours of in-depth and deep archival footage, which director Sara Dosa weaves together fervently to create a sweeping portrait of two people passionately in love with science, nature, and each other.

"Have you ever loved something so much, you would sacrifice your life for it?" We're left to contemplate this stirring hypothetical question as we're led through the vividly rich life of French scientists Katia and Maurice Krafft. Voiceover narration is provided by filmmaker and performance artist Miranda July, who so sensitively captures the couple's self-proclaimed "outsider" and "weirdo" personas. From their first meeting in 1966 to the very last image before their untimely

death in 1991, the common thread throughout Fire of Love is the Krafft's commitment to curiosity and exploration, which overrode any sense of fear.

Katia and Maurice documented volcanoes from all over the world, capturing some of the most breathtaking images in the process. Dressed like extras from Wes Anderson's The Life Aquatic in light blue onesies and red beanies, Katia and Maurice are as goofy as they are brilliant, and were as close to soul mates as you can get (if you believe in
